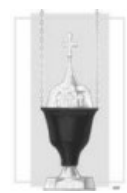

Tip of the Week

How to prevent hearing loss:

- Limit time wearing earbuds
- Wear ear protection when using noisy equipment
- Avoid prolonged exposure to noise
- Don't use Q tips, they can cause injury
- Dry your ears thoroughly after water exposure

What you can do if you experience a hearing loss:

- Get a physical exam - hearing loss can be related to ear wax build up or infection which are easily treatable.
- Have a hearing test - this can often be done in your primary care doctor's office
- Use closed caption on your TV, audio assist device in the movies and adaptive features for your phone.
