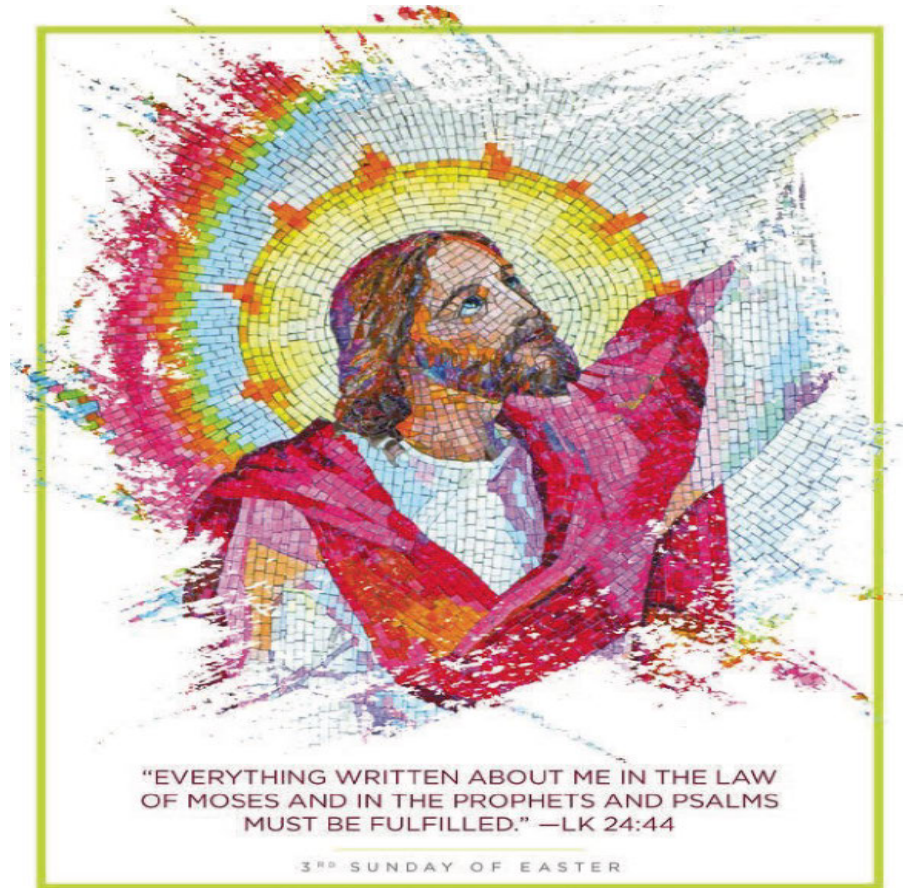

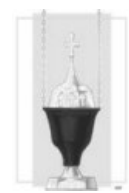

Health & Wellness Corner Tip of the Week

April is Autism Awareness and Acceptance Month

Autism spectrum disorder (ASD) is a neurologic and developmental disorder that affects how people interact with others, communicate, learn and behave.

Symptoms generally appear in the first 2 years of life.

Delayed milestones:

- Trouble with verbal and non verbal communication
- Difficulties adjusting behaviors to social situations
- Little or no eye contact
- Displaying facial expressions, movements and gestures that do not match what is being said

Unique strengths:

- May excel in math, science, music or art
- Can be strong visual and auditory learners
- Can learn things in detail and remember information for long periods of time

Early identification and intervention are key

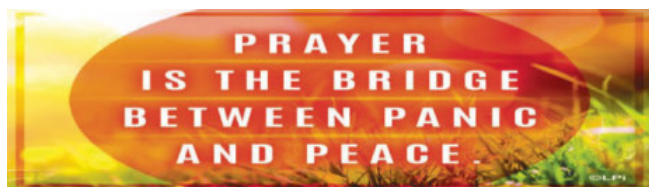
