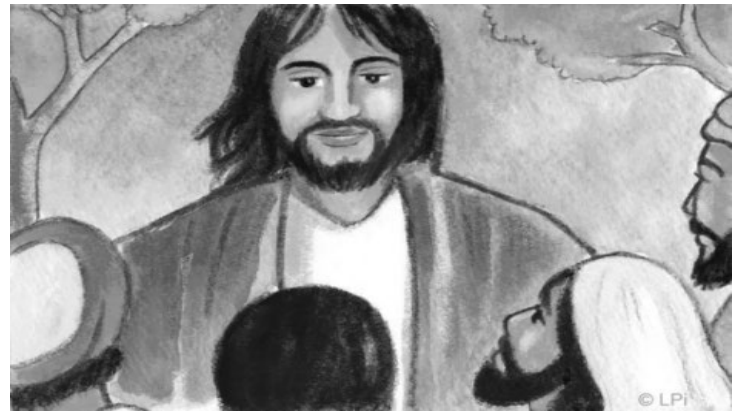

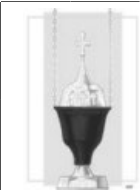

Parkinsons Disease

A progressive disorder that effects the nervous system

Early symptoms may include:

- Tremors in hands, legs, arms, jaw or head
- Change in muscle control, balance and movement
- Mask like expressions that change very little or not at all
- Voice changes, slower or slurred speech
- Dizziness
- Constipation
- Sleeplessness

Early diagnosis is helpful as there are treatments available.

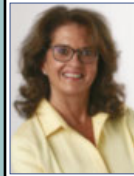
