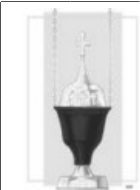

Tip of the Week

What is ALS?

Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis also known as Lou Gehrig's Disease

This is a disorder of progressive muscle weakness that can lead to movement problems such as trouble swallowing, speaking and breathing.

Symptoms can occur at any age but may occur 40 to 70 years old and is more common in men and include:

- **Muscle weakness starting in the arms/legs**
- **Trouble walking or doing usual daily activities**
- **Difficulty eating or speaking**
- **Muscle tightness, stiffness, cramps or twitching**
- **Uncontrolled outbursts of laughing or crying**
