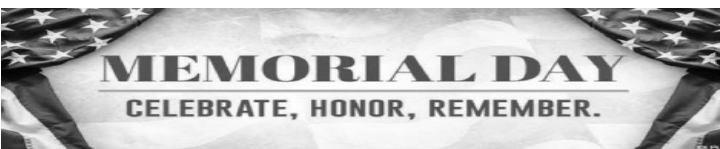

**Thyroid Part Two**

The most common causes of thyroid disease include: genetic predisposition, autoimmune diseases, stress, nutritional deficiencies, sedentary lifestyle and environmental pollution

Early symptoms can be slow or rapid heartrate, unexplained weight loss or weight gain, fatigue, sensitivity to cold or heat, constipation, depression or anxiety, dry skin, brittle hair and nails, menstrual irregularities

If you have any of these symptom, seek evaluation by your primary care physician. You may also need to see an endocrinologist.
