

What is Gastroparesis?

It is slowing of digestion which can cause GI distress including abdominal pain, bloating and constipation.

Risk Factors:

Diabetes
Abdominal or esophageal surgery
Medications
Infection, usually from a virus
Nervous system diseases, i.e. Parkinsons
Thyroid Disease

Signs & Symptoms:

Vomiting, nausea, abdominal bloating and pain, a feeling of fullness after eating a few bites, lack of appetite, acid reflux, changes in blood sugar.
