



Health & Wellness Corner Tip of the Week

What are varicose veins? Varicose veins appear as swollen or raised leg veins and are often blue or dark red in color. If your varicose veins are causing a lot of pain or damaging your overall health, other treatment options are available. The recommended treatment depends on your symptoms, size and location of the varicose vein. These options may include:

Sclerotherapy, which involves injecting a solution into the vein. The solution irritates the vein, causing the walls to collapse. The vein closes off and harmlessly remains in the body. Ambulatory phlebectomy, a mini-surgical technique that involves removing varicose veins through multiple, small (less than 2 mm) slits made in the skin overlaying the vein. Endovenous laser ablation therapy (EVLT), which uses light energy to collapse a vein. Radiofrequency ablation (RFA), which relies on heat and radiofrequency waves to close off weakness in the vein walls.

All of these treatments are minimally invasive and very well tolerated, and can be performed right in our office.



ST. IGNATIUS LOYOLA

This week we celebrate a spiritual master! Not only is St. Ignatius Loyola the founder of the Jesuits, but the legacy of his life of prayer -- now called Ignatian

spiritualty --inspired believers the world over. Injured as a young soldier, Ignatius spent his time in recovery reading the lives of the saints. They inspired his soul to holy heroism, changing his life forever. Ignatius gathered a group of friends who also desired to be "contemplatives in action," finding God in all circumstances. This became the Jesuits -- a great missionary and teaching order. Ignatius himself was constantly attuned to his own inner promptings. This self-knowledge -- open to the movements of the Holy Spirit -- led him to be an incredibly astute spiritual director. For Ignatius, recognizing God as the first principle of one's life determined everything. How has God changed you?
