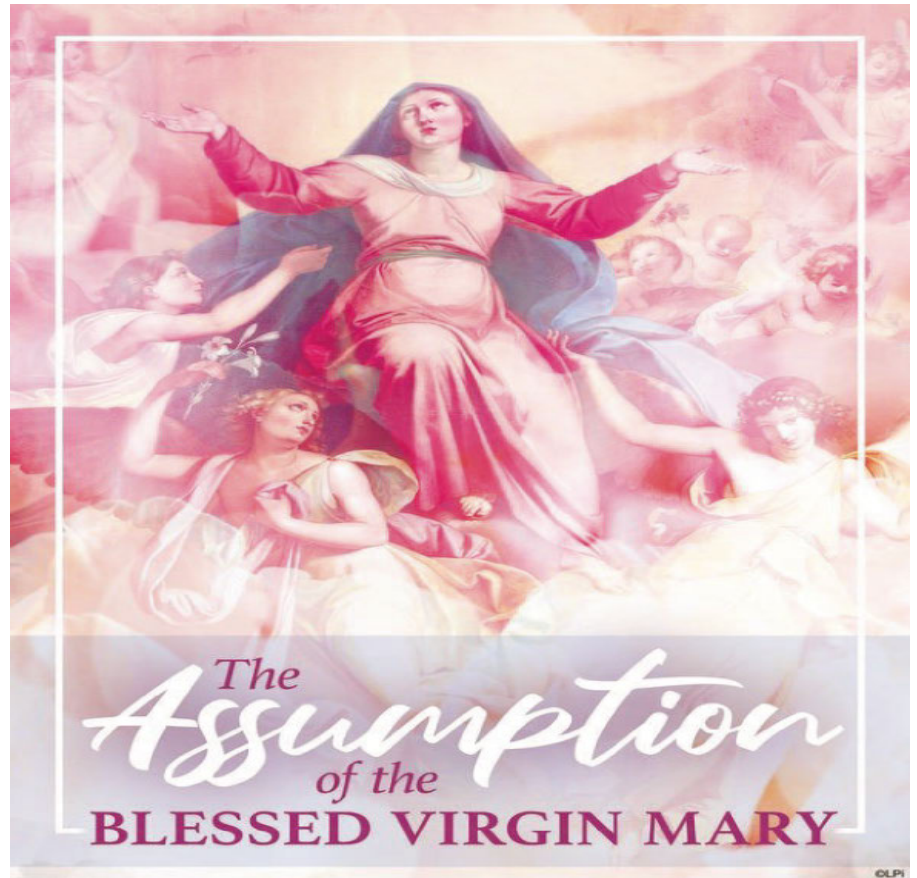

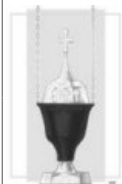

Are You Up to Date with your Vaccines

Adult vaccine recommendations:

Flu shot- annually in the fall

COVID- annually, may be combined with flu vax

Pneumovax- for adults >65yrs or if immunocompromised 19-64yrs

Shingles- 50+yrs or immunocompromised

RSV- >60yrs & seasonally during pregnancy

Tetanus- every 10 years or sooner if sever injury

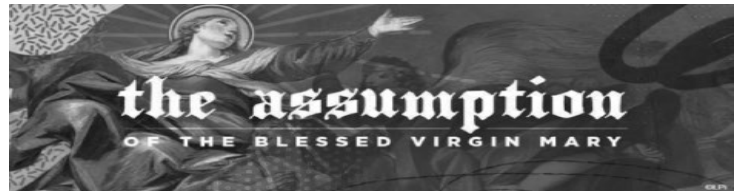

The Assumption: A Sign of Hope Thursday, August 15th Holy Day of Obligation
