

Back to School Series: Sleep Tips

Establish a bedtime routine

- Create a comfortable sleep environment quiet, dark, cool (68-72 degrees), white noise
- Limit screen time at least 1 hour before bedtime
- Avoid caffeine or large meal for 3 hours before bedtime

Transition from Summer Vacation to back to School:

- shift bedtime gradually starting 2 weeks before school starts
- set bedtime 20-30 minutes earlier and wake time 20-30 minutes earlier
