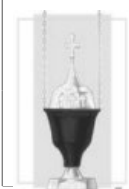

Tip of the Week

What is Gastroparesis?

It is slowing of digestion which can cause GI distress including abdominal pain, bloating and constipation

Risk Factors:

- Diabetes
- Abdominal or esophageal surgery
- Medications
- Infection, usually from a virus
- Nervous system diseases-Parkinsons & Thyroid Disease

Signs & Symptoms:

Vomiting, nausea, abdominal bloating & pain, a feeling of fullness after eating a few bites, lack of appetite, acid reflux, changes in blood sugar.
