

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

A poor couple expecting a child at any minute, complying with the call to be counted, found themselves in a strange town with no available lodging.

Shepherds – the poorest of the poor – experienced an angelic call to go to Bethlehem and encounter a savior.

*Magi from the East – foreigners and strangers – were captivated by the light of a star and found themselves paying homage to the newborn King.* 

We hear the gospel accounts of Jesus' birth in a unique way each year. We bring the past year's joys and struggles with us to hear the story of Bethlehem again. This year, the people of The Church of the Resurrection and Most Holy Trinity Parish hear this story in the midst of a journey that is drawing the Catholics of Wallingford back into a single community of faith. Like Mary and Joseph, we may feel we're in an unfamiliar or even strange time. Like them, a new life is upon us. As the shepherds and Magi, we find ourselves meeting new people with different histories, cultures, and perspectives. I see in the stories of the Nativity, an important reflection of our own experience this year.

We know that fear accompanies all change. That's why the 65angel's words to the shepherds, "Do not be afraid," likely take on special meaning now as does their promise of good news and great joy for all the people. Throughout Advent we call upon Jesus under the title of *Emmanuel*, which means "God with us." Truly, it is this reality - that God is always with us - that allows us to be fearless in the face of change.

I especially can relate to the Magi and their travels to follow God's call in new lands! With all my heart I thank you for the warm outreach you have shared with me over these four months; I am blessed to serve among you. On behalf of the clergy and staff of the parish, may the Christ child bless you and your families abundantly and deepen the bonds of faith, hope, and charity among us.
