

Health & Wellness Corner Tip of the Week

Rheumatoid Arthritis (RA)

RA is a chronic inflammatory disease usually affecting the small joints of the hands and feet but can affect skin eyes, heart and blood vessels

Early signs and symptoms of RA

- Prolonged morning stiffness
- Inability to move a joint normally
- Swelling, warmth and/or tenderness in multiple joints
- Fatigue
- Fever
- Loss of Appetite

Family history is a strong risk factor for RA

It is important to see your health care provider if you have symptoms; early diagnosis can prevent disease progression.
