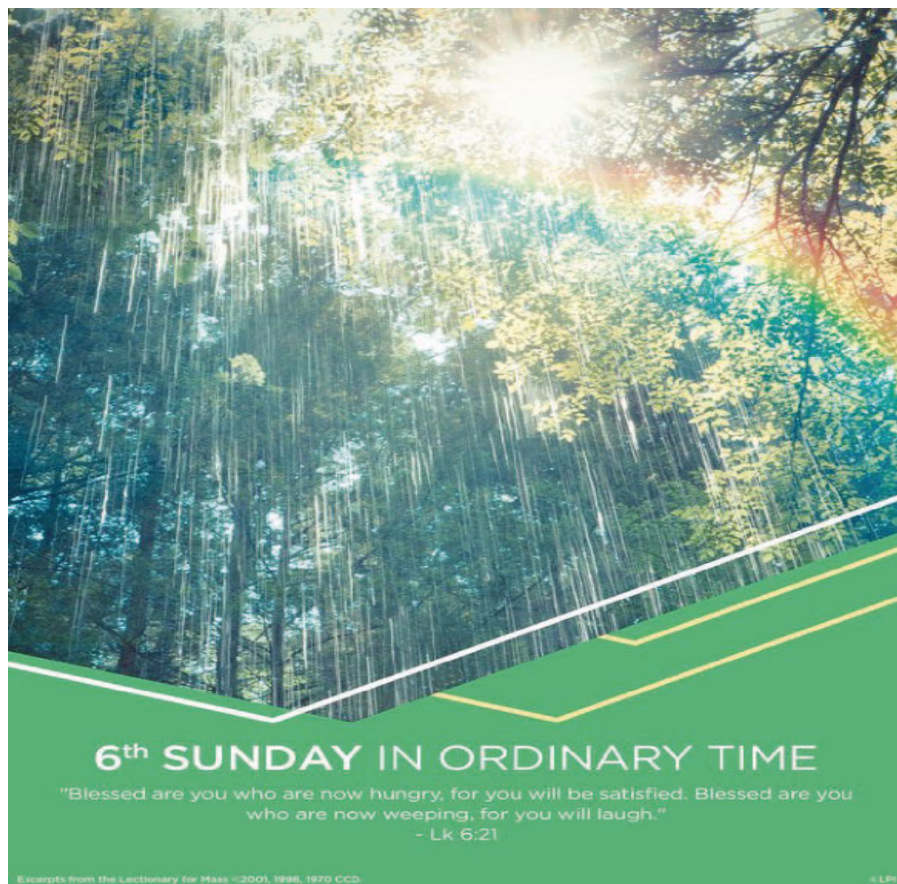

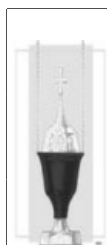

**Health & Wellness Corner**  
Tip of the Week

**What is Raynauds?**

A disorder that affects small blood vessels in the extremities resulting in reduced blood flow

- When exposed to cold blood vessels start to spasm causing cyanosis (blue tinged skin at the tips of extremities), tingling, numbness, or pain
- Fingers are most typically affected but symptoms may also be in toes, ears or the tip of your nose
- When you warm up, they become red as spasm resolves and normal blood flow resumes

**There are two types of Raynauds**

- Primary- most common- not associated with an underlying condition
- Secondary- usually linked to an underlying condition such as lupus, rheumatoid arthritis or other autoimmune diseases

Prevention: dress warmly before cold exposure!
