

# Health & Wellness Corner Tip of the Week

### **Poison Prevention**

First aid measures make a difference when accomplished within minutes of a poison exposure.

- Exposure can be inhaled, swallowed, skin or eye contact
- Call 911 immediately if the individual collapses, has a seizure, trouble breathing or cannot be awakened.
- Call Poison Control at 1-800-222-1222
   They will ask what the exposure was and provide guidance
   In general: If swallowed: drink a small amount of water or milk If in the eye: rinse immediately with room temperature water for 15-20 minutes If on the skin: remove contaminated clothing, rinse with room

temperature water or shower for 15 minutes

If inhaled: move to fresh air immediately
