Health & Wellness Corner
Tip of the Week

Rosacea

Rosacea may cause the following symptoms on the face:
Redness, rash, or flushing
Visible blood vessels
Skin thickening/prominent pores
Eye irritation
Swollen bumps
Burning sensation

This is most common in middle age and older adults, women, people with fair skin or a family history.

The cause is unknown however it is not contagious and is treatable.

Triggers can be: sun, wind, exercise, hot or spicy foods or drinks, alcohol or cosmetics.

See a dermatologist if you have ongoing symptoms to rule out other causes and treatment.

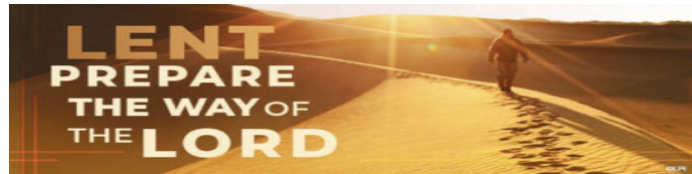

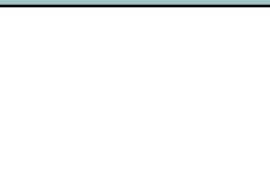
