



Today, we sing the acclamation from which we have fasted since March 5th: Alleluia!

Alleluia! Translated from the Hebrew, the word means "Praise God!" On this most holy day, the entire Church celebrates our core belief – that Christ is risen from the dead. In his first letter to the Church at Corinth, Saint Paul put it clearly: "...if Christ was not raised, your faith

is worthless," and again, "If our hopes in Christ are limited to this life only, we are the most pitiable of men."

Christ's first disciples *experienced* him alive after the resurrection, but he also was changed. Because of that experience, they brought his message of life-giving Good News throughout the known world. No doubt, they faced skepticism and ridicule. Many were persecuted and martyred for clinging to that belief. Think about the power of their witness to Christ, his gospel, and his risen life. If none of it were true, would they have gone to their deaths rather than let go of their claim? What great hope they had in God – even in the face of struggle.

We live in times of challenge. Perhaps we've heard people say they feel disheartened for many reasons. Maybe we've felt that ourselves. That is one reason Pope Francis' proclamation of 2025 as a Jubilee Year of Hope is so critically important. In proclaiming the Jubilee, the Holy Father said, "Everyone knows what it is to hope. In the heart of each person, hope dwells as the desire and expectation of good things to come, despite our not knowing what the future may bring...God's word helps us find reasons to hope."

God's word proclaimed to us on Easter is the ultimate reason to hope! Christ has overcome hatred, sin, and death. The gospel shows us the way to overcome the first two. Christ promises the third to those who follow him in faith. What more could give us hope in all of life's joys and struggles?

The risen Christ gives me great hope through your presence in the parish and all that you do for God's people. It is with gratitude that I, on behalf of the entire staff, wish you a joyous Easter and continued rejoicing in his promise throughout the season. May God bless us with a deep encounter with Christ this Easter and a strengthening of our hope in him. Saint Benedict, pray for us on our path forward together.
