

WORDS FROM FATHER MICHAEL

It is hard to believe that this is my final bulletin column. I have written roughly 200 of these quick reflections/announcements for the bulletin. Even more amazing, many people have read and even commented to me about the content of these columns. I am grateful for the opportunities I have had to write.

As this bulletin covers both Holy Family Sunday and Epiphany, and also Christmas and the Solemnity of the Mary, the richness of these two weeks is endless. Merry Christmas and Happy New Year to you all!

I have received so many notes, gifts, and had so many conversations with all of you that my heart is full. Thank you. I cannot say thank you enough.

Many of you have shared the good things that God has done in your life during the last five years. Some of these things included words or actions that I did which communicated something of the love of God. Part of the wonder of the life of a priest are the hidden ways that God has been at work. When I was a new priest, I was hearing confessions for the first time at Saint Joseph's in Poquonock. I was so nervous I could barely think. Two people came to confession that Saturday afternoon. It was then I began to realize that being here is "normal" life for me, but for the person on the other side of the screen it is a moment to encounter God's grace. It is an awesome realization that what has become ordinary to my life – anointings, funerals, baptisms, weddings, confessions, and celebrating Mass – these moments are charged with God's grace to change lives. Most of the time, probably to keep me from being overwhelmed by this reality, I have no idea of what God is accomplishing through me. Now at this time of transition, I get a glimpse of what God has been doing. I am grateful beyond words for you, for God's grace, and my time here. You will always be in my prayers and Our Lady of Hope parish will always be in my heart.





Our final Advent Classes of 2021 continued to explore the liturgical calendar and the meaning of the different Advent candles. We focused on the Blessed Mother, and some classes created Nativity scenes. We discussed the angel Gabriel's visit to Mary, Mary's visit to Elizabeth, and the Holy Family's journey to Bethlehem. There was a

lot of activity to be covered in learning about these Gospel readings! We read lyrics and listened to songs such as "Angels We Have Heard on High," "Away in a Manger," "Silent Night," and "Go Tell it on the Mountain!" to help give us an idea of what it might have been like on that first Christmas night. Mary, Joseph, Elizabeth, and the shepherds all faced experiences and/or visitors who were new and different to them; they could have reacted with great fear (and the shepherds were indeed "so afraid"), but we learned that all of these saintly people (and the shepherds eventually, too) focused on the **joy** of the Good News that the angels brought to them, and to the whole world! Joy to the World! Merry Christmas to all students, parents, and catechists! Thank you for participating in our religious education program.
