Words from Father John

My Dear Friends,

Today is considered the birthday of the Church, Pentecost Sunday. It is the day when the Apostles and the Blessed Virgin Mary received the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. It was on Pentecost that the Apostles were given the strength of the Holy Spirit to go out into the whole world and preach the Good News. It was the Holy Spirit that allowed the Apostles to speak in their own language but to be understood by men and women who spoke other languages. It was the Holy Spirit that set the world on fire to renew the face of the earth. It was the Holy Spirit that confirmed the Apostles and early disciples in their respective charisms to build up the Body of Christ. And the most amazing thing though all of this is that it is still the Holy Spirit today that continues to strengthen and sanctify and teach us today the Good News. Through the Sacrament of Baptism and the Sacrament of Confirmation we receive the Holy Spirit and become not only His dwelling place but also the means to fight the spiritual battle in Christ's name. It is also through the Holy Spirit that we are renewed with the Holy Spirit that is lost to us when

we commit mortal sin but returns to us when we have been absolved. It is also the Holy Spirit that animates our liturgies, most especially animating our Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, as we worship the Triune God. The Mass is the representation of Christ's

sacrifice on the Cross. We are mystically returning to the foot of the Cross when we attend Mass and when we receive Holy Communion are brought into a deeper communion with the Triune God. It is always vitally important for us to remember that Mass is a worship experience where we thank the Father for His gift of His Son and the Holy Spirit. We as the collective Body of Christ are united in our worship as brothers and sisters to give God, and God alone, all the glory and praise. May God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, be praised now and always. Happy Pentecost!

Charlie Buonocore was a wonderful young man who died in a car accident at the age of 18. His death and that of Melissa Andrew will always be felt deeply by those who knew and loved them. A few years ago, his family established a scholarship to honor the memory of this extraordinarily generous and good-hearted young man. A scholarship of \$1000 is awarded each year to a student who is furthering his or her education in the fall of that year. The recipient must be a registered member of Our Lady of Hope Parish. The scholarship is available to a graduating senior or continuing student who will be attending a vocational school, two year school, four year college or one of our nation's service academies. Selection will be based on community and parish service, citizenship, financial need and an evaluation of the applicant's essay on the importance of service to others. Applications are due by June 30. They are available at the main entrance of both churches or by calling the Parish Office at 860.379.5215.

Confirmation Students of 2022: Soon to be back by popular demand: Pathways to Discipleship! Our Confirmation Class of 2022 has completed their 9th Grade Religious Education school year, and have only a few more classes left in the fall before receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation at the Cathedral of Saint

Joseph in Hartford! In the meantime, I thought you might enjoy reading a little about some of the students' saint projects: As I mentioned last week, our 9th Graders chose quite a variety of saints this year for their Confirmation names! Last week, we learned about Joan of Arc, who was originally considered a heretic and a witch! It took 500 years for her to become canonized! This week, let's take a look at Saint Sebastian, the patron saint of soldiers and athletes. He lived from 255 – 285 A.D. During the Great Persecution of Christians, the Roman Emperor sentenced Sebastian to be used for target practice! Though he was struck by "countless arrows," he still survived, and went on to confront the Emperor, trying to convince him to stop the persecutions. He went on to be martyred as a great hero of our faith, never having backed down from promoting faith in Christ. Thank you Jack M. for this fascinating research into Saint Sebastian!



Pentecost Prayer: We hope you have enjoyed the Easter Season and Ascension prayers we have been publishing here over the past 50 days. Pentecost is a wonderful opportunity to talk to children about the presence and power of the Holy spirit in our lives.

When we say that Jesus is always with us, it's actually his **Holy Spirit** that he has sent to us who is our Helper and Comforter, and who we have received at our Baptism. Here is a prayer which we can say to ask for His guidance:

Leader: Let us pray. (The response is "Come, Holy Spirit.")

Reader 1: For the gift of wisdom for ourselves, for the Church, and for world leaders, we pray to the Lord.

Reader 2: For the gift of understanding, that we may come to know the meaning of God's action and presence in our lives. For the gift of right judgment that we will make choices that will lead us to grow as His children, we pray to the Lord.

Reader 3: For the gift of courage to live as true disciples of Jesus. For the gift of knowledge to see our lives through God's eyes, we pray to the Lord.

Reader 4: For the gift of reverence to love and worship God and respect all of his creation. For the gift of wonder and awe to recognize how great God is, we pray to the Lord.

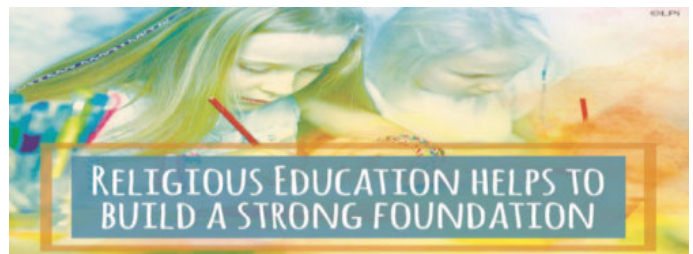
