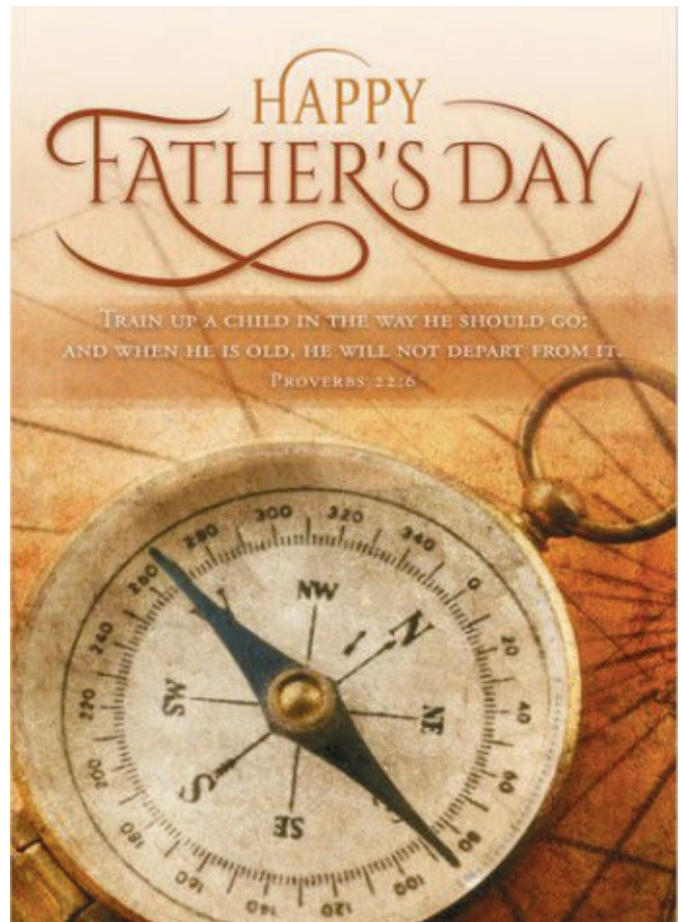

## Words from Father John

My Dear Friends,

Today, besides being Father's Day, is the great feast of our faith, The Holy Body and Blood of our Lord, also commonly called Corpus Christi in Latin. With so many Catholics, including those who attend Mass regularly, not believing in the teaching of our faith that Jesus is truly present, Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity, it is an opportune time to remind us that along with the teaching on the Trinity, the Incarnation, the Resurrection and Ascension, and the four last things, death, judgment, heaven and hell, the teaching on the Real Presence is a central belief of our faith. The Holy Sacrifice of the Mass can be celebrated by the priest alone, or with only a couple of the faithful present or in front of thousands. The Mass can be celebrated without singing as well as with or without music accompaniment. The Mass can be celebrated in a very humble church setting or chapel or in a majestic basilica or cathedral. The Mass can be celebrated in various languages, including the language of our faith, Latin. Whether you attend Mass in Latin, or any other language that is not your primary language and in which you do not understand, the Mass accomplishes what our faith teaches. The desire of the Second Vatican Council was that the vernacular languages could be used instead of Latin so that the people would better understand what is happening at Mass. Yet, when the Mass was celebrated in Latin, over 90 percent of the people understood the Real Presence and understand the need to be quiet and respectful and reverent in the Church building. Since the Second Vatican Council and the use of vernacular languages, people understand even less in our Church, not only in their belief that the Eucharist is only a symbol, but also in rejecting the Church's teaching on sexual morality and contraception, mortal and venial sin, the efficacy of our sacraments, including Matrimony and Confession, and no discernable knowledge of the Ten Commandments, the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy and the Precepts of the Church. With more of our treasures opened up before us in our vernacular language, the faith, and knowledge of the faith, has diminished. Yet those who still attend Mass in Latin have a stronger understanding of the Real Presence as well as are knowledgeable in the teachings of our faith. When the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is rightly understood to be a true sacrifice and an entering into the Paschal Mystery of our Lord for the forgiveness of our sins and for the glory of God, and not understood or

experienced as entertainment to make us feel better, then the Catholic faithful will once again see the beauty of our teaching on the Real Presence. On this feast of Corpus Christi, let us remain after Mass in our pews and pray in front of our Blessed Sacrament, exposed on the altar, (and begin to make an effort to visit the church throughout the day, especially in Eucharistic Adoration), and lift up in prayer all of our fathers and pray that this fatherlessness epidemic in our families and in the priesthood of our Catholic Church will be turned and we will once again see strong fathers lifting their wives and children up in prayer and strong priests exercising their role as a true, spiritual father in their parishes. God bless

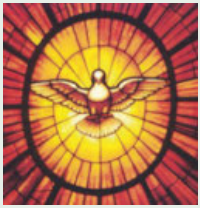

## Confirmation Students of 2022:

Over the past month or so, we have been looking at the exciting, inspiring lives of some of the saints who the 9th Graders have chosen as their patron saints for Confirmation. This week, we'll start to explore some of the Gifts of the Holy Spirit the students have learned about and discussed. Did you know that there are seven (7) gifts the Holy Spirit gives us when we are anointed at our Baptism and strengthened at our Confirmation? Each of us experiences certain gifts more fully than some of the other gifts. The 7 Gifts of the Spirit are as follows: Wisdom, Understanding, Right Judgment, Courage, Knowledge, Reverence, Wonder and Awe. Let's take a look at some student-answers to this question: "If you could choose only one Gift of the Holy Spirit, which would it be, and why? How does this gift help your relationship with Jesus and with other people?" One student chose the **Gift of Understanding**, because "I think everyone needs to be more understanding of others. I learned this during the pandemic. I think Jesus is very understanding of others, and we all should be more like him."

## Sunday Vespers:

- ⇒ According to the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, "Evening Prayer (also called Vespers) is part of the Liturgy of the Hours, also known as the Divine Office. In the Liturgy of the Hours, the Church fulfills Jesus' command to "pray always" (Luke 18:1; see also 1 Thessalonians 5:17). Through this prayer, the people of God sanctify the day by continual praise of God and prayers of intercession for the needs of the world." (USCCB.org/prayer-and-worship)
- ⇒ Did you know that we **sing (a capella)** these prayers at Immaculate Conception Church in New Hartford on Sunday evenings? Father Michael began this practice for our parish during this past Advent, and a small group of us have continued doing so, led by our 6th-7th Grade Catechist/ Parish Life Coordinator Emily Delventhal.
- ⇒ We would love to have more people of all ages join us! So if you love music and you desire to grow closer to God, **come to Immaculate Conception Church at 5:00 p.m. on Sunday evening** for about 20 minutes of singing prayer. You'll end your afternoon and begin your evening on a peaceful, Godly note. All are welcome!
