Words from Father John

My Dear Friends,

This past Saturday we celebrated the feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, the patronal feast day of our Church in Harwinton. The Immaculate Heart of Mary is a beautiful devotion that has been around for centuries and was a devotion fostered by St. John Eudes. We celebrate the feast day of St. John Eudes on August 19th. Interestingly, when Our Lady appeared at Fatima on May 13th for the first of her six apparitions, she continued to appear on the 13th of each month, except for August. During August, Our Lady appeared on August 19th, the very same feast day of her priest, St. John Eudes, who had a strong devotion to her Immaculate Heart. In fact, it was Our Lady of Fatima and her appearances that reminded the popes and all of her Son's faithful people, that her Immaculate Heart would triumph. The Blessed Mother requested that Russia be consecrated to her Immaculate Heart and that we practice the first Saturday devotion to her Immaculate Heart. This first Saturday devotion to her Immaculate Heart mirrors another first Saturday practice that began in 1905, when Pope St. Pius X approved and granted indulgences for the practice of the first Saturdays for 12 consecutive months in honor of the Immaculate Conception. The Immaculate Heart of Mary devotion of five first Saturdays was explained to Sr. Lucia in 1925 when she was a postulant in the Dorothean convent in Spain. Our Lady said, "Behold, my daughter, my Heart encircled with thorns, with which ungrateful men pierce it at every moment by their blasphemies and ingratitude. Give



me consolation, you, at least; and make known on my behalf that I promise to assist at the hour of death, with the graces necessary for salvation, all who on the first Saturday of five consecutive months confess their sins, receive Holy Communion, recite five decades of the Rosary, and keep me company for fifteen minutes meditating on the mysteries of the Rosary, with the purpose of making

reparation to my Immaculate Heart." Our Lord appeared to Sr. Lucia in 1930 to explain why His Blessed Mother asked for five Saturdays. Our Lord said that it was to make reparation for the five kinds of offenses and blasphemies against the Immaculate Heart; a. blasphemies against her Immaculate Conception; b. blasphemies against her perpetual virginity; c. blasphemies against the divine and spiritual maternity; d. blasphemies involving the rejection and dishonoring of her images; and e. the neglect of implanting in the hearts of children a knowledge and love of this Immaculate Mother. The promises attached to those who practice this devotion are the following; a. salvation of your own soul; b. salvation for sinners; and c. peace in the world. Because this is a popular and worthy devotion, I am implementing at Our Lady of Hope Parish the practice of first Saturday Masses, beginning next week on July 2nd and following on every first Saturday of the month. Mass will be at 9 AM at the Immaculate Heart of Mary Church. God bless





If you have knowledge or suspect that a minor or vulnerable adult (an adult with an intellectual disability) has been sexually abused, in any manner, by personnel of the Archdiocese of Hartford, you are urged to report this information to:

In addition, you will be asked to follow up in writing with a detailed description of the facts involved in the incident. Specifics of this written report can be found in the <u>Policies and Procedures</u> of the Archdiocese of Hartford Relating to Allegations of Sexual <u>Misconduct Involving Minors and Vulnerable Adults.</u> This document is also available online at <u>www.archdioceseofhartford.org.</u> The Archdiocese of Hartford will report any and all incidents to the proper civil authorities.

Mandated reporters in the State of Connecticut are required by law to report any incident of sexual abuse involving a minor or vulnerable adult. We encourage any Non-Mandated persons to report such incidents to the proper authorities as well. We support your right to do so.

Incidents involving sexual abuse of minors (persons under the age of 18) should be reported to:

Once a written report of an incident of sexual abuse of a minor or vulnerable adult has been received, an investigation will be undertaken by, or on behalf of, the Archdiocese of Hartford.
