## Words from Father John

My Dear Friends,

The month just flew right by. Today is the last day of July and the feast day of St. Ignatius of Loyola, the founder of the Society of Jesus (Jesuit Fathers). The Jesuits were a powerhouse religious order and a force to be reckoned with. Many great saints, besides the founder, came from this religious order, including,



St. Francis Xavier, St. Robert Bellarmine, St. Isaac Jogues, St. Francis Borgia, St. John de Brebeuf, St. Edmund Campion, St. Peter Canisius, St. Peter Claver, St. Peter Favre, St. Aloysius Gonzaga, St. Stanislaus Kostka, St. Paul Miki and Blessed Miguel Pro. They were great missionaries, spiritual directors, teachers, pastors, and theologians. Many of the martyrs died defending the faith. Beginning in the 1950's and into the early 1970's and up to present day, many Jesuits began pushing the boundaries, especially with the moral teachings of our faith. One such Jesuit, Fr. Robert Drinan, was a congressman from the state of Massachusetts and regularly voted for the right for abortion throughout his ten years in Congress. He was so notoriously pro-abortion rights that when he died, Nancy Pelosi gave a glowing eulogy for him at his Mass of Christian Burial. He is just one example of many Jesuits that are still trying to this day to change the Church's perennial teachings on moral issues and sexuality. One wonderful Jesuit who fought to uphold the moral teachings of our faith is the Servant of God, Fr. John Hardon. 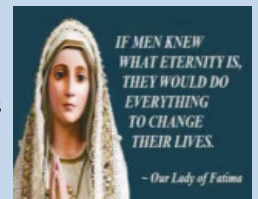

**WHY DO WE DO THAT? - CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED**

**Gospel Differences**

**Question:**

Why do the Gospels differ in their details? I was surprised to learn that not all of the Gospels tell the same stories, for example, the Nativity. Doesn't this take away from their credibility?

**Answer:**


Take any event that happens, from family trips to national politics and ask two or three different people to explain what happened. You will get a different version of the same story. People tend to tell the story from their perspective, and past experience shades what we recall and how we recall it. Our choice of words and what details we leave in or out is also influenced by the audience who is listening to our tales.

The Gospel writers are no different. Each one tells the story of Jesus from their own perspective. Versions differ in some details, not because one is true and the other is not, but because each Gospel writer, or Evangelist, has a different theological point to communicate as well as a different audience for whom he is writing. He picks and chooses the details of his Gospel based on what message he is preaching, what his audience may already know, and what message they need to hear. The various details of the Gospels point more to their authenticity as a record of the church's experience and understanding of Jesus. In a good study Bible, the background notes for each Gospel contain a lot of information that helps us better understand each Evangelist and his message.
