

Words from Father John

My Dear Friends,

Monday, August 8th, is the feast day of St. Dominic, the founder of the Dominican Fathers and Brothers, officially known as the Order of Preachers. St. Dominic was a contemporary of St. Francis of Assisi, the founder of the Friars Minor, also known as the Franciscans. There were many spirited debates between members of the two religious orders. There are many great Dominican saints besides St. Dominic. Some common ones are St. Albertus Magnus, St. Thomas Aguinas, St. Vincent Ferrer, Pope St. Pius V, St. Martin de Porres, and two female Dominican saints, St. Rose of Lima and St. Catherine of Siena. Like the Jesuits, though, there have been some Dominicans since the 1960's and 1970's who have pushed the boundaries of moral theology and seek the changing of the moral teachings of our Catholic faith, including sexual morality. As a seminarian I myself was taught by the Dominican Fathers in Washington DC at the Dominican House of Studies. I had some wonderful professors there, including Fr. Giles Dimock (Eucharist and Mariology), Fr. Basil Cole (Moral Theology), Fr. Peter John Cameron (Preaching), Fr. John Corbett (Moral Theology) and Fr. (now Archbishop) Augustine DiNoia (Dogmatic Theology). I was truly blessed to have studied under Dominicans and other seminarian professors who are faithful to the moral and doctrinal teachings of our faith, unlike many other seminaries in the United States and other countries who still continue to push the boundaries of our faith. One of many blessings that I received from my time in the seminary was my love for the Holy Rosary, which is traditionally understood to have been given to St. Dominic himself. The rosary played an important role in the life of the holy Pope St. Pius V, who asked all of Europe to pray the rosary when they went to battle against the Muslims in the Battle of Lepanto. Because of the success of the battle, Pope St. Pius instituted the feast of the Holy Rosary (also called our Lady of Victory) on October 7th. On this feast of St. Dominic tomorrow, let us make an effort, if we don't already do it, to begin a daily rosary devotion in our prayer lives. After the Eucharist and the Mass, the rosary is the most powerful weapon we have as Catholics. St. Dominic, pray for us. St. Pius V, pray for us. God bless


