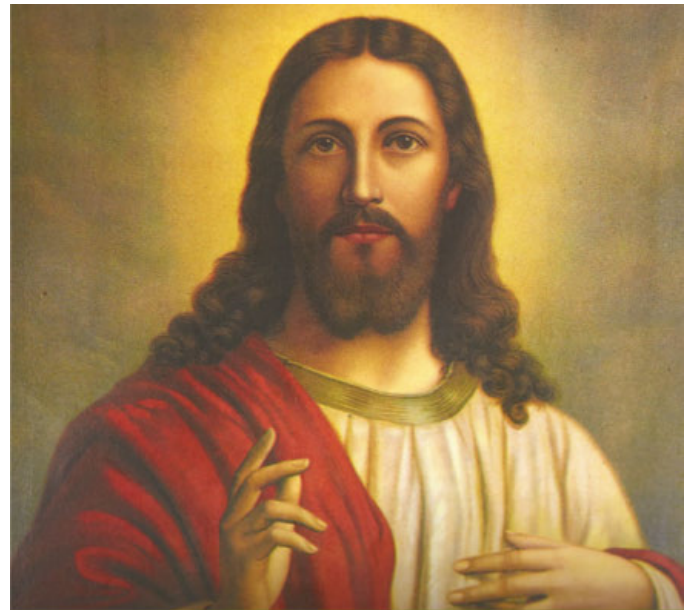

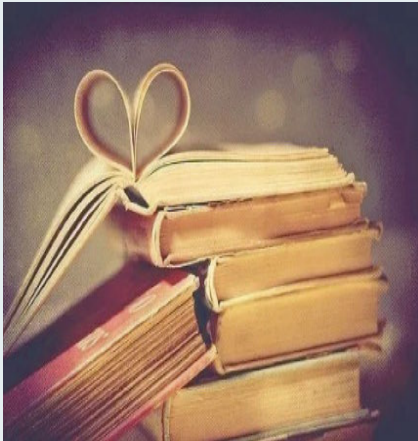

## LIVE THE LITURGY

Discipline is essential if we are going to discover our desire for union with our Creator and live in God's house. In this way, we will not risk finding the door locked when we need it to be open.

A favorite Bible passage of Sean's is Isaiah 40:31\*. He says that "as a track and field athlete, I find this inspiring."
