



## Words from Father John

My Dear Friends,

Last week we celebrated the Solemnity of the Assumption. This week, on the octave day of the Assumption, we celebrate the Queenship of Mary. These are the fourth and fifth Glorious Mysteries of the Most Holy Rosary. We rightly honor the Blessed Mother and we with joy we call her Queen of Heaven and earth. As Scott Hahn reminds us in his book, *Hail, Holy Queen*, and Brant Pitre writes in his book, *Jesus and the Jewish Roots of Mary*, the title of queen mother goes back to Solomon and was handed down through the line of kings. It was the queen mother who interceded for the people and who was the principal advisor to the king, her son; it was not the wife of the king that fulfilled that role. As we remember Mary this week as the queen of heaven and earth, it is an opportune time once again for us to pick up our rosaries and pray the rosary every day, asking our Blessed Mother for her prayers for peace in the world, for the conversion of Russia, in reparation for the sins of the flesh, and for an end to abortion. In honoring the Blessed Mother, we are also making reparation for the sins and offenses against her. In the Rite of Benediction after the people have been blessed by the priest (or deacon) with the monstrance, the priest (or deacon) will lead us in the Divine Praises. It is here where we say the following dogmas of Mary: Blessed be the great Mother of God, Mary most holy; Blessed be her holy and immaculate conception; Blessed be her glorious assumption; Blessed be the name of Mary, Virgin and Mother; Blessed be Saint Joseph, her most chaste spouse. Let us pray: Hail Holy Queen, Mother of mercy, our life, our sweetness and our hope. To thee do we cry, poor banished children of Eve. To thee do we send up our sighs, mourning and weeping in the vale of tears. Turn then, most gracious advocate, thine eyes of mercy towards us, and after this, our exile, show unto us the blessed Fruit of thy womb, Jesus. O clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin Mary. Pray for us o Holy Mother of God that we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

### **Connecting Kids to Justice:**

Thank you for donating to Catholic Relief Services' Connecting Kids to Justice outreach project to help provide clean, accessible drinking water to poor families around the world. This summer, our Vacation Bible School students participated in this project, and they learned that not everyone is as fortunate as we are in having clean water at our disposal. Here are some facts published by CRS:

- More than 750 million people in the world do not have access to safe water, and nearly 2 billion people do not have access to treated water.
- 3.5 billion people in the world do not have access to adequate sanitation.
- round 700,000 children die every year from diarrhea caused by unsafe water and poor sanitation.
- For every \$1 spent on water, sanitation and hygiene programs, there is, on average, a \$4 return in productivity.

Our parishioners are very generous! The VBS children's families donated \$197 during the Vacation Bible School week, and when added to the donations contributed at all Masses last weekend, the total amount raised was 1,006.00. You have helped CRS to support families in need around the world by increasing access to clean water—an essential lifesaving service—to villages and communities in need. Thank you for making a difference in the lives of these families.
