This is an exciting time for us here at St. Damien Parish. The extensive renovation project at St. Augustine Church is now underway. It is our hope that this project will be completed by Palm Sunday, April 10, 2022. As part of our project we will be purchasing and installing new altar furnishings. We have contracted with ArTech Church Interiors to build us a custom designed Altar, Ambo (podium), Presider's Chair, Deacon's Chair, Baptismal Stand, and Credence Table. We have contracted with Alaskan Bronze to cast for us a new bronze baptismal font. I would like to offer the parishioners and friends of St. Damien an opportunity to memorialize or contribute to the costs of these Altar Furnishings. A plaque will be affixed to these altar furnishings prior to the rededication by Bishop Sullivan at the completion of the project.

COVID Update from your Nurse Ministry

We have seen a surge over the past few weeks of increased COVID due to the Omicron variant. The Omicron variant is highly contagious. The CDC and the State of New Jersey have outlined steps we all should be taking to protect ourselves.

- 1) If not already vaccinated, you can still start or finish your series. You can walk-in without an appointment every Wednesday in January from 2-5 PM at the Avalon Rec Center at 3pm and the Boardwalk in Avalon. No appointment is necessary, just bring your card, this service is free. Moderna and J&J are available, and you can also mix and match Pfizer and Moderna.
- 2) Pfizer and Moderna vaccines should receive a booster 5 months after the second shot, and J&J two months after the first shot.
- 3) Face Masks are strongly suggested at indoor settings and especially in any setting where others around you may not be wearing masks or distancing is not possible.
- 4) Frequent hand washing and use of sanitizer is highly recommended.
- 5) If you are sick, stay home. This variant is highly virulent. Omicron variant may be without symptoms or show symptoms of sore throat, fatigue and congestions. Only about 50% of the cases will have a fever. If unsure, stay home, call your Primary Care Provider and get tested. It is safer even if you have had the vaccine to assume you are positive and isolate. Go to CDC.gov or NJ.gov for updates.

Even though 2021 was a year of restrictions, that limited community activity and public fundraising, our Parish Knights of Columbus have been very active and very generous with over \$15,000 distributed to local charities.

- Our local Catholic Schools received donations of \$1,000
- Donations to support our seminarians, various charities and Individual assistance of \$1,475.

When you contribute to any of the Knights fundraisers, 100% of the proceeds go directly to charitable organizations!

The Knights are deeply involved with our Parish from coordinating the Communion Breakfast, Spaghetti Dinners, Fish Fries, and other fundraisers combined with Evangelizing through our Rose Drives for Life, Religious Magnets available at Christmas and Easter, and even through distribution of religious articles at the O.C. Block Parties.

Our members are always "on-call" offering assistance for small maintenance projects for our Parish, which this year included:

- relocating furniture and equipment before the sale of the various properties,
- removing the leaking fountain and painting the lobby at Our Lady of Good Counsel Church,
- constructing trash corrals at Our Lady of Good Counsel Church and the Parish Center.
