Divine Mercy Sunday



Divine Mercy Novena begins on Good Friday, April 15, in preparation for the Feast of Divine Mercy on Sunday, April 24.

Our Lord revealed the secrets of His Great Mercy to Saint Faustina from 1931 to 1938. He designated the first Sunday after Easter as the Feast of Divine Mercy. In preparation of this feast, Our Lord asked St. Faustina to pray a Novena, for a different group of souls each of the nine days, in order to immerse them in the sea of God's Mercy.

In preparation for, and to fittingly observe, the great Feast of Divine Mercy, all are invited to:

- 1) Take a copy of the "Divine Mercy Novena and Chaplet" located near the main church entrance. (Blessed rosaries are also available.)
- 2) The First Day Novena Prayer and Chaplet begins on Good Friday, April 15th; the Ninth Day Novena Prayer and Chaplet is on Saturday, April 23rd.
- 3) Plan to go to Confession before Divine Mercy Sunday, and sincerely repent of all your sins.
- 4) Receive Holy Communion on Divine Mercy Sunday.
- 5) Place complete trust in Jesus.
- 6) Be merciful to others.
