

Not to the patient who is dead, not to the family, not to the colleagues or institution who may blame him/her. There must be a Being whom he/she turns to draw consolation: GOD. You may not always succeed, but know that each time you stop to cure or care, you are acting in God's name, and on his behalf. He will not leave you alone. The society will not always understand, but He will. Let this be your consolation in times of discouragement."






