Parish Membership: We and request welcome new members to our Parish family you register in the Parish as soon as possible. Active membership is determined by registration, faithful participation and giving of one's time, talent and resources to this community of faith. **The parish cannot issue certificates of eligibility for sacramental sponsorship, give recommendations or character references if a person is not an active parishioner.**

The Sacrament of Baptism: Baptism is the celebration through which a child is brought into the faith of the Catholic Church. Parents must be registered and practicing members of the parish. Parents and sponsors are required to attend a pre-baptismal class. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics in good standing and able to obtain a certificate of eligibility from their parish.

Sacrament of Matrimony: The Sacrament of Matrimony requires a time of spiritual, intellectual and emotional preparation. Couples should arrange with the Parish Office one (1) year prior to the wedding date. Please call the parish office for an appointment with the pastor prior to making any other wedding plans.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: Anyone who feels called by God to become a member of the Catholic Church participates in the RCIA Program. A series of instructions and liturgical ceremonies designed to give total formation in the Catholic Faith.

From the Pastor

Dear brothers and sisters,

As we enter a New Year, we pray that the Holy Family will bless and protect our families. "Jesus, God's Word," we are told, "was born into a family of listeners." May the example of Jesus, Mary and Joseph give us guidance as we go about our daily lives and listen to God's calls.

During the past few months, our parish has undergone some major changes. Since November 2018, we no longer have an Associate Priest. Fr. Pauly who now resides in our Rectory has a full-time ministry as chaplain at Robert Wood Johnson Hospital. In the absence of a full-time Associate, we have to invite other priests to celebrate some of our weekday and weekend Masses. This has required some restructuring. Beginning in January 2019, there will be two Masses on Mondays: 8:00 am at St. Paul's and 9:00 am at Guardian Angels along with the Miraculous Medal and St. Jude novenas. On Tuesdays there will be no Mass celebration in either Church except on holy days of obligation.

During the first week of November, our Korean community was reassigned to Our Lady of Mercy, South Bound Brook. This change has created an expected shortfall of \$65,000 in our Parish's annual income, and to address this loss we will be reducing the Parish Office hours. As of January 2019, the office will be open Monday to Thursday 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM, and Friday 9:30 AM to 12:30 PM. The Administrative Assistant's position will be part-time.

Moving forward, we continue to pray that each one of us will have an enriching and transforming experience of God's mysteries and love.

Amoris Laetitia: Love is not rude

100. To be open to a genuine encounter with others, "a kind look" is essential. This is incompatible with a negative attitude that readily points out other people's shortcomings while overlooking one's own. A kind look helps us to see beyond our own limitations, to be patient and to cooperate with others, despite our differences. Loving kindness builds bonds, cultivates relationships, creates new networks of integration and knits a firm social fabric. In this way, it grows ever stronger, for without a sense of belonging we cannot sustain a commitment to others; we end up seeking our convenience alone and life in common becomes impossible. Antisocial persons think that others exist only for the satisfaction of their own needs. Consequently, there is no room for the gentleness of love and its expression. Those who love are capable of speaking words of comfort, strength, consolation, and encouragement. These were the words that Jesus himself spoke: "Take heart, my son!" (Mt 9:2); "Great is your faith!" (Mt 15:28); "Arise!" (Mk 5:41); "Go in peace" (Lk 7:50); "Be not afraid" (Mt 14:27). These are not words that demean, sadden, anger or show scorn. In our families, we must learn to imitate Jesus' own gentleness in our way of speaking to one another.

National Migration Week—January 6-12, 2019

This week is an opportunity for us to reflect on the circumstances confronting migrants, including immigrants, refugees and survivors of human trafficking. This year's theme is "Building Communities of Welcome." We celebrate this them as we continue the "Share the Journey campaign," a global effort by the Church to show love to our migrant and refugee neighbors. During National Migration Week let us take the opportunity to engage migrants as community members, neighbors and friends.

PARISH MINISTRIES AND STEWARDSHIP

Called to Ministry & Service: "As each one has received a gift, use it to serve one another as good stewards of God's varied grace." 1 Peter 4:10. Transfiguration of the Lord Parish offers various ministry opportunities to grow in faith and service. We encourage all of our parishioners to serve in some way as part of their faith. Development Committee: The Development Committee works in close coordination with the Pastor. Members identify parish needs and find the necessary resources to fulfill them to be able to expand the mission of our parish.

Social Committee: Members help organize social events of the parish.

Decoration Committees (Guardian Angels and St. Paul's): These Committees are responsible for decorating Guardian Angels and St. Paul's churches for Advent, Christmas, Palm Sunday, Easter Sunday, and other important days during the year.

Grounds Committees (Guardian Angels and St. Paul's): Committee members look after gardening and landscaping parish grounds at Guardian Angels and St. Paul's.

Liturgy Committee: Members plan and organize common liturgical functions on important days such as Easter Vigil Mass, Parish Feast, etc.

Ushers: The Ushers greet parishioners coming to celebrate the Eucharistic celebration. They are responsible for seating the congregation, guiding them at times of movement, preparing the Offertory procession, taking up the collection, and distributing the Church bulletin.

Sacristans: Prepares for liturgical celebrations.

Altar Servers: Children (grades 4 and up) serve at Sunday and Holy Day Masses in Church. Training is provided. Adults are welcome to serve at the Sunday Masses.

Lectors: Proclaim the Word of God at the Sunday Liturgy and Holy Days of Obligation and read announcements. Young people grades 5 to 12 are invited to join the Lector ministry.

Eucharistic Ministers: Extraordinary Ministers aid the clergy in distributing the body and blood of our Lord during Mass. They also bring the Eucharist to those who are unable to attend Mass because of illness or advanced age.

Ministry to the Homebound: Extraordinary Communion Ministers bring Communion to homebound parishioners who are unable to attend Mass.

Music Ministry/Choir: Serve God and the parish community through music leadership at the liturgies. Encourages participation of musical persons of all ages and musical talents.

Counters: These volunteers assume the responsibility of counting and banking the Sunday and Holy day collections.

Catechists for Religious Education: Our catechetical program is designed to support parents in their role as the primary religious educators of their children. The catechists are dedicated volunteers, who are committed to the Church and want to share their faith with young people. You can volunteer as a catechist, aide, or office helper.
