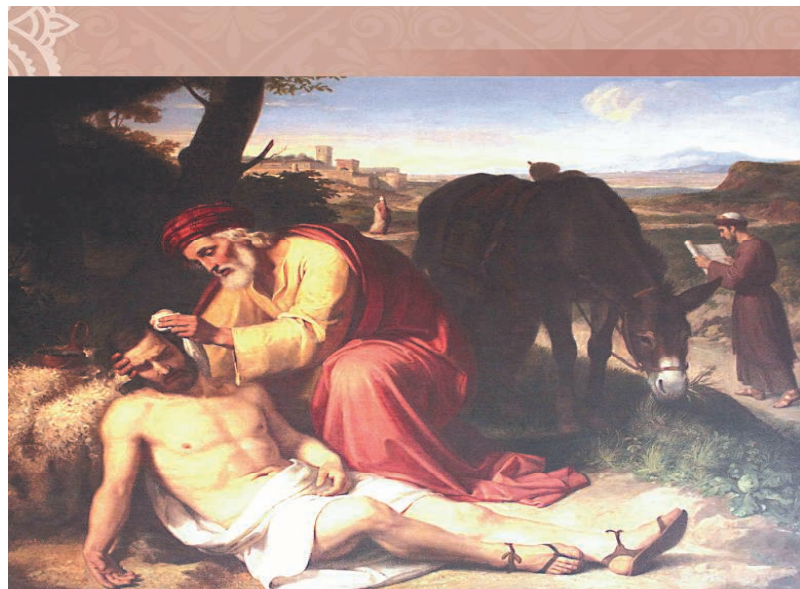

**Parish Membership:** We welcome new members to our Parish family and request you register in the Parish as soon as possible. Active membership is determined by registration, faithful participation and giving of one's time, talent and resources to this community of faith. **The parish cannot issue certificates of eligibility for sacramental sponsorship, give recommendations or character references if a person is not an active parishioner.**

**The Sacrament of Baptism:** Baptism is the celebration through which a child is brought into the faith of the Catholic Church. Parents must be registered and practicing members of the parish. Parents and sponsors are required to attend a pre-baptismal class. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics in good standing and able to obtain a certificate of eligibility from their parish.

**Sacrament of Matrimony:** The Sacrament of Matrimony requires a time of spiritual, intellectual and emotional preparation. Couples should arrange with the Parish Office one (1) year prior to the wedding date. Please call the parish office for an appointment with the pastor prior to making any other wedding plans.

**Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults:** Anyone who feels called by God to become a member of the Catholic Church participates in the RCIA Program. A series of instructions and liturgical ceremonies designed to give total formation in the Catholic Faith.

### Important:

- The Diocese of Metuchen requires that all parish religious education personal regardless of their roles, are to be practicing Catholics.
- The Catechist Mission Statement defines the intent of the catechist to teach only what the Catholic Church believes and professes.
- High School students who take on this responsibility must have previous experience as an Aide.
- It is mandatory for employees and volunteers in the Diocese of Metuchen, 18 years of age or older, having more than a one-time contact with a minor as defined under New Jersey law, to undergo fingerprinting and a criminal background check in accordance with the policy set forth in the "Policy on Criminal Background Checks" found in Addendum 9 of the Diocesan Policy and Handbook. (FYI if this is completed it must be renewed every 3 years)
- It is mandatory that all catechists/volunteers participate in the VIRTUS program developed to educate adult in identifying and preventing child sexual abuse. The program involves attending in person training and completing ongoing modules online.

## Missionary Cooperatives Sunday

This weekend, July 13-14, the second collection will be the Missionary Cooperative Plan for COAR.

Our speaker will be Mary Stevenson, Executive Director of the COAR Peace Mission, the U.S. fundraising and outreach arm of the COAR Children's Village in Zaragoza, El Salvador. She was a student at Beaumont High School in Cleveland Heights when Sr. Dorothy Kazel, OSU, left to begin her five-year assignment on the Cleveland Diocese's Latin American Mission Team. Prevented from visiting the mission in the 1980's because of the civil war, including the murder of Sr. Dorothy, Mary first visited COAR in 1990 and experienced the anguish of El Salvador's civil war through the orphans at COAR. Repeated visits through the years revealed the deep, healing, vital nature of the care, education, and vocation training that COAR gives its children. Won over by COAR, Ms. Stevenson left a business career to become Executive Director in 2004.

COAR will be making a mission appeal asking for your prayers, awareness, and generosity this weekend of July 13-14. Founded in 1980 at the beginning of El Salvador's civil war, COAR is the Community of Oscar A. Romero, a school, foster care facility, clinic and other services for the impoverished children of El Salvador. Por motivos de la guerra civil en la década de 1980 y por el asesinato de la Hna. Dorothy, la Sra. Stevenson no pudo visitar la misión de COAR hasta el 1990. Allí experimentó la angustia de la guerra civil de El Salvador a través de los huérfanos en COAR. Las visitas repetidas a lo largo de los años revelaron la naturaleza profunda, sanadora, vital del cuidado, la educación y la capacitación vocacional que COAR brinda a sus niños. Convencida por la organización de COAR, la Sra. Stevenson dejó una carrera en el mundo de los negocios para ser la Directora Ejecutiva de COAR en el 2004. COAR hará una petición de misión o de sus oraciones, conciencia y generosidad este fin de semana del 13 al 14 de julio. Esta organización fundada en el 1980 al comienzo de la guerra civil de El Salvador, es la comunidad de Oscar A. Romero, una escuela, centro de acogida de niños huérfanos, clínica y otros servicios para los niños empobrecidos de El Salvador.
