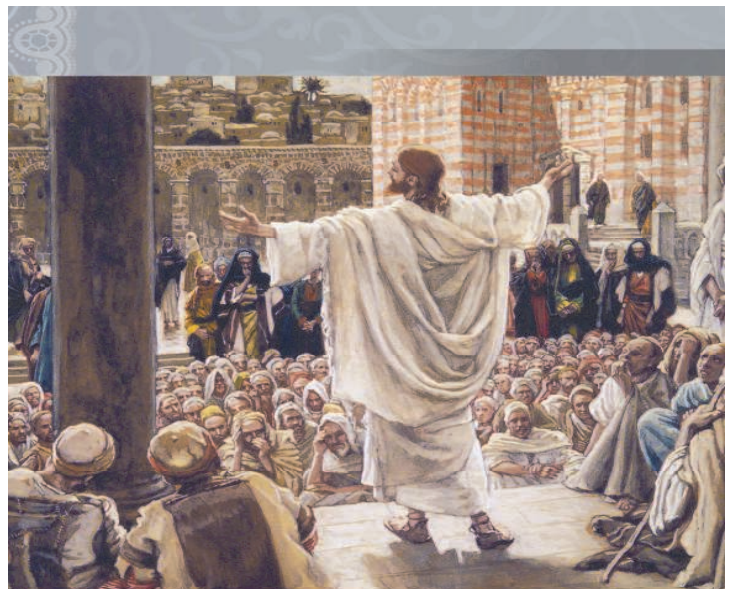
Parish Office Hours—Monday through Thursday—9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. - Friday—9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

Parish Membership: We welcome new members to our Parish family and request you register in the Parish as soon as possible. Active membership is determined by registration, faithful participation and giving of one's time, talent and resources to this community of faith. **The parish cannot issue certificates of eligibility for sacramental sponsorship, give recommendations or character references if a person is not an active parishioner.**

The Sacrament of Baptism: Baptism is the celebration through which a child is brought into the faith of the Catholic Church. Parents must be registered and practicing members of the parish. Parents and sponsors are required to attend a pre-baptismal class. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics in good standing and able to obtain a certificate of eligibility from their parish.

Sacrament of Matrimony: The Sacrament of Matrimony requires a time of spiritual, intellectual and emotional preparation. Couples should arrange with the Parish Office one (1) year prior to the wedding date. Please call the parish office for an appointment with the pastor prior to making any other wedding plans.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: Anyone who feels called by God to become a member of the Catholic Church participates in the RCIA Program. A series of instructions and liturgical ceremonies designed to give total formation in the Catholic Faith.

Question for Children: What is one way you can be closer to Jesus today?

Youth Ministry

Anyone who was recently Confirmed at Transfiguration is certainly welcome to come to these events as well!

Amoris Laetitia: A love that reveals itself and increases 134. All this occurs through a process of constant growth. The very special form of love that is marriage is called to embody what Saint Thomas Aquinas said about charity in general. "Charity", he says, "by its very nature, has no limit to its increase, for it is a participation in that infinite charity which is the Holy Spirit... Nor on the part of the subject can its limit be fixed, because as charity grows, so too does its capacity for an even greater increase". Saint Paul also prays: "May the Lord make you increase and abound in love to one another" (1 Th 3:12), and again, "concerning fraternal love... we urge you, beloved, to do so more and more" (1 Th 4:9-10). More and more! Marital love is not defended primarily by presenting indissolubility as a duty, or by repeating doctrine, but by helping it to grow ever stronger under the impulse of grace. A love that fails to grow is at risk. Growth can only occur if we respond to God's grace through constant acts of love, acts of kindness that become ever more frequent, intense, generous, tender and cheerful. Husbands and wives "become conscious of their unity and experience it more deeply from day to day". The gift of God's love poured out upon the spouses is also a summons to constant growth in grace.

Important:

- The Diocese of Metuchen requires that all parish religious education personal regardless of their roles, are to be practicing Catholics.
- The Catechist Mission Statement defines the intent of the catechist to teach only what the Catholic Church believes and professes.
- High School students who take on this responsibility must have previous experience as an Aide.
- It is mandatory for employees and volunteers in the Diocese of Metuchen, 18 years of age or older, having more than a one-time contact with a minor as defined under New Jersey law, to undergo fingerprinting and a criminal background check in accordance with the policy set forth in the "Policy on Criminal Background Checks" found in Addendum 9 of the Diocesan Policy and Handbook. (FYI if this is completed it must be renewed every 3 years)
- It is mandatory that all catechists/volunteers participate in the VIRTUS program developed to educate adult in identifying and preventing child sexual abuse. The program involves attending in person training and completing ongoing modules online.
