Parish Membership: We welcome new members to our Parish family and request you register in the Parish as soon as possible. Active membership is determined by registration, faithful participation and giving of one's time, talent and resources to this community of faith. **The parish cannot issue certificates of eligibility for sacramental sponsorship, give recommendations or character references if a person is not an active parishioner.**

The Sacrament of Baptism: Baptism is the celebration through which a child is brought into the faith of the Catholic Church. Parents must be registered and practicing members of the parish. Parents and sponsors are required to attend a pre-baptismal class. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics in good standing and able to obtain a certificate of eligibility from their parish.

Sacrament of Matrimony: The Sacrament of Matrimony requires a time of spiritual, intellectual and emotional preparation. Couples should arrange with the Parish Office one (1) year prior to the wedding date. Please call the parish office for an appointment with the pastor prior to making any other wedding plans.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: Anyone who feels called by God to become a member of the Catholic Church participates in the RCIA Program. A series of instructions and liturgical ceremonies designed to give total formation in the Catholic Faith.

From the Pastor

Dear parishioners,

At a recent combined meeting of our Parish councils and committees on Thursday, January 23rd, the leadership discussed the necessity and prospects of restructuring our present weekday Mass schedule. Of course, our priority continues to be providing ongoing pastoral and spiritual care to all our parishioners. At the meeting, we addressed the limited number of priests that we now have available for celebrating our daily Masses. Transfiguration of the Lord Parish is not alone facing this kind of constraint due, in part, to priest shortages, one-priest parishes, merged parishes with two or more churches and other limiting resources. Therefore, considering our current Mass schedule and looking toward the future, we determined that beginning on Friday, May 1st, the new weekday Mass schedule will be as follows:

Monday, Wednesday and Friday at 8 AM at St. Paul's.

Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday at 9 AM at Guardian Angels.

These revisions mean that we will have only one Mass a day on weekdays instead of the two Masses that we currently have. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation as we introduce this new schedule. Please pray for vocations.

Amoris Laetitia: Marriage and Virginity

161. The value of virginity lies in its symbolizing a love that has no need to possess the other; in this way it reflects the freedom of the Kingdom of Heaven. Virginity encourages married couples to live their own conjugal love against the backdrop of Christ's definitive love, journeying together towards the fullness of the Kingdom. For its part, conjugal love symbolizes other values. On the one hand, it is a particular reflection of that full unity in distinction found in the Trinity. The family is also a sign of Christ. It manifests the closeness of God who is a part of every human life, since he became one with us through his incarnation, death and resurrection. Each spouse becomes "one flesh" with the other as a sign of willingness to share everything with him or her until death. Whereas virginity is an "eschatological" sign of the risen Christ, marriage is a "historical" sign for us living in this world, a sign of the earthly Christ who chose to become one with us and gave himself up for us even to shedding his blood. Virginity and marriage are, and must be, different ways of loving. For "man cannot live without love. He remains a being that is incomprehensible for himself, his life is senseless, if love is not revealed to him".

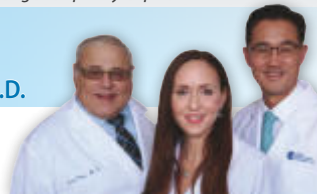
