Parish Membership: We welcome new members to our Parish family and request you register in the Parish as soon as possible. Active membership is determined by registration, faithful participation and giving of one's time, talent and resources to this community of faith. **The parish cannot issue certificates of eligibility for sacramental sponsorship, give recommendations or character references if a person is not an active parishioner.**

The Sacrament of Baptism: Baptism is the celebration through which a child is brought into the faith of the Catholic Church. Parents must be registered and practicing members of the parish. Parents and sponsors are required to attend a pre-baptismal class. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics in good standing and able to obtain a certificate of eligibility from their parish.

Sacrament of Matrimony: The Sacrament of Matrimony requires a time of spiritual, intellectual and emotional preparation. Couples should arrange with the Parish Office one (1) year prior to the wedding date. Please call the parish office for an appointment with the pastor prior to making any other wedding plans.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: Anyone who feels called by God to become a member of the Catholic Church participates in the RCIA Program. A series of instructions and liturgical ceremonies designed to give total formation in the Catholic Faith.

From the Pastor

Our 2020 Parish Lenten Project

Dear brothers and sisters, Next week we begin the season of Lent. It is a time during which the Church encourages us to grow spiritually particularly through the three pillars of almsgiving, prayer and fasting. While fasting and prayer may be undertaken individually according to one's own capabilities and opportunities, once again, our parish will also provide other programs to help us grow and deepen in our spiritual lives. Jesus gave his life for us that we may have life. In giving alms we share from our own resources at a cost to help others in their needs. At the January meeting of our parish councils and committees, the leadership has decided to undertake collective almsgiving as a community through a Lenten Project that will assist others elsewhere in our country. Through Catholic Extension, we will help to fund four ministries : 1. Support Sister Silvia Chacon and the Santa Teresa Parish in the Diocese of El Paso, TX; 2. Support the Tekakwitha Center in the Diocese of Crookston, MN; 3. Support the Human Development Project in the Diocese of Brownsville, TX; 4. Provide operating support for rural parishes in the Diocese of Lexington, KY. More information about these ministries will be given in the coming weeks. Our goal is to raise \$10,000 for these deserving ministries, and throughout the weeks of Lent, we will have second collections for this purpose. Thank you for your willingness and sacrifices in support of our almsgiving project.

Amoris Laetitia: Marriage and Virginity

162 Celibacy can risk becoming a comfortable single life that provides the freedom to be independent, to move from one residence, work or option to another, to spend money as one sees fit and to spend time with others as one wants. In such cases, the witness of married people becomes especially eloquent. Those called to virginity can encounter in some marriages a clear sign of God's generous and steadfast fidelity to his covenant, and this can move them to a more concrete and generous availability to others. Many married couples remain faithful when one of them has become physically unattractive, or fails to satisfy the other's needs, despite the voices in our society that might encourage them to be unfaithful or to leave the other. A wife can care for her sick husband and thus, in drawing near to the Cross, renew her commitment to love unto death. In such love, the dignity of the true lover shines forth, inasmuch as it is more proper to charity to love than to be loved. We could also point to the presence in many families of a capacity for selfless and loving service when children prove troublesome and even ungrateful. This makes those parents a sign of the free and selfless love of Jesus. Cases like these encourage celibate persons to live their commitment to the Kingdom with greater generosity and openness. Today, secularization has obscured the value of a life-long union and the beauty of the vocation to marriage. For this reason, it is "necessary to deepen an understanding of the positive aspects of conjugal love".

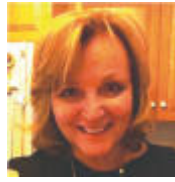

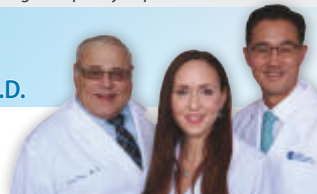
