The parish cannot issue certificates of eligibility for sacramental sponsorship, give recommendations or character references if a person is not an active parishioner.


The Sacrament of Baptism:

Baptism is the celebration through which a child is brought into the faith of the Catholic Church. Parents must be registered and practicing members of the parish. Parents and sponsors are required to attend a pre-baptismal class. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics in good standing and able to obtain a certificate of eligibility from their parish.

Sacrament of Matrimony: The Sacrament of Matrimony requires a time of spiritual, intellectual and emotional preparation. Couples should arrange with the Parish Office one (1) year prior to the wedding date. Please call the parish office for an appointment with the pastor prior to making any other wedding plans.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: Anyone who feels called by God to become a member of the Catholic Church participates in the RCIA Program. A series of instructions and liturgical ceremonies designed to give total formation in the Catholic Faith.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: Any parishioner who is sick, aged or incapacitated may receive the Eucharist at home. Please contact the Parish Office to have a priest visit you at home or in the hospital.

Sinodo 2021 –2013: Por Una Iglesia Sinodal DOCUMENTO PREPARATORIO

6. Esta situación, que, no obstante las grandes diferencias, une a la entera familia humana, pone a prueba la capacidad de la Iglesia para acompañar a las personas y a las comunidades para que puedan releer experiencias de luto y de sufrimiento, que han encubierto muchas falsas seguridades, y para cultivar la esperanza y la fe en la bondad del Creador y de su creación. Sin embargo, no podemos escondernos: la misma Iglesia debe afrontar la falta de fe y la corrupción también dentro de ella. En particular, no podemos olvidar el sufrimiento vivido por personas menores y adultos vulnerables «a causa de abusos sexuales, de poder y de consciencia cometidos por un notable número de clérigos y personas consagradas»4. Continuamente somos interpelados «como Pueblo de Dios a asumir el dolor de nuestros hermanos vulnerados en su carne y en su espíritu»5: por mucho tiempo el de las víctimas ha sido un clamor que la Iglesia no ha sabido escuchar suficientemente. Se trata de heridas profundas, que dificilmente se cicatrizan, por las cuales no se pedirá nunca suficiente perdón y que constituyen obstáculos, a veces imponentes, para proceder en la dirección del "caminar juntos". La Iglesia entera está llamada a confrontarse con el peso de una cultura impregnada de clericalismo, heredada de su historia, y de formas de ejercicio de la autoridad en las que se insertan los diversos tipos de abuso (de poder, económicos, de conciencia, sexuales). Es impensable «una conversión del accionar eclesial sin la participación activa de todos los integrantes del Pueblo de Dios»6: pidamos juntos al Señor «la gracia de la conversión y la unción para poder expresar, ante estos crímenes de abuso, nuestra compunción y nuestra decisión de luchar con valentía».

consideration the child's age and abilities, without presuming to apply rigid and inflexible methods. The valuable contributions of psychology and the educational sciences have shown that changing a child's behaviour involves a gradual process, but also that freedom needs to be channeled and stimulated, since by itself it does not ensure growth in maturity. Situated freedom, real freedom, is limited and conditioned. It is not simply the ability to choose what is good with complete spontaneity. A distinction is not always adequately drawn between "voluntary" and "free" acts. m a y person c 1 e a r 1 y and willingly desire something evil, but do so as the result of an irresistible passion or a poor upbringing. In such cases, while the decision is voluntary, inasmuch as it does not run counter to the inclination of their desire, it is not free, since it is practically impossible for them not to choose that evil. We see this in the case of compulsive drug addicts. When they want a fix, they want it completely, yet they are so conditioned that at that moment no other decision is possible. Their decision is voluntary but not free. It makes no sense to "let them freely choose", since in fact they cannot choose, and exposing them to drugs only increases their addiction. They need the help of others and a process of rehabilita-

- •Call or write to an estranged friend or family member
- •Give someone a second, third or fourth chance, even if you may feel it is unwarranted
- •Reflect on your own humility and place yourself in other people's shoes
- •Cultivate a forgiving heart through a devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus
- Teach forgiveness to others, especially the children in your life or those in your parish
- Recognize your own need for mercy and receive it freely from Jesus, so it becomes easier to forgive the offenses of others.

MESSAGE OF THE HOLY FATHER for Lent 2022

What about the harvest? Do we not sow seeds in order to reap a harvest? Of course! Saint Paul points to the close relationship between sowing and reaping when he says: "Anyone who sows sparsely will reap sparsely as well, and anyone who sows generously will reap generously as well" (2 Cor 9:6). But what kind of harvest are we talking about? A first fruit of the goodness we sow appears in ourselves and our daily lives, even in our little acts of kindness. In God, no act of love, no matter how small, and no "generous effort" will ever be lost (cf. Evangelii Gaudium, 279). Just as we recognize a tree by its fruits (cf. Mt 7:16, 20), so a life full of good deeds radiates light (cf. Mt 5:14-16) and carries the fragrance of Christ to the world (cf. 2 Cor 2:15). Serving God in freedom from sin brings forth fruits of sanctification for the salvation of all (cf. Rom 6:22). In truth, we see only a small portion of the fruits of what we sow, since, according to the Gospel proverb, "one sows, while another reaps" (Jn 4:37). When we sow for the benefit of others, we share in God's own benevolent love: "it is truly noble to place our hope in the hidden power of the seeds of goodness we sow, and thus to initiate processes whose fruits will be reaped by others" (Fratelli Tutti, 196). Sowing goodness for the benefit of others frees us from narrow self-interest, infuses our actions with gratuitousness, and makes us part of the magnificent horizon of God's benevolent plan.
