Active membership is determined by registration, faithful participation and giving of one's time, talent and resources to this community of faith. **The parish cannot issue certificates of eligibility for sacramental sponsorship, give recommendations or character references if a person is not an active parishioner.**

The Sacrament of Baptism:

Baptism is the celebration through which a child is brought into the faith of the Catholic Church. Parents must be registered and practicing members of the parish. Parents and sponsors are required to attend a pre-baptismal class. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics in good standing and able to obtain a certificate of eligibility from their parish.

Sacrament of Matrimony:

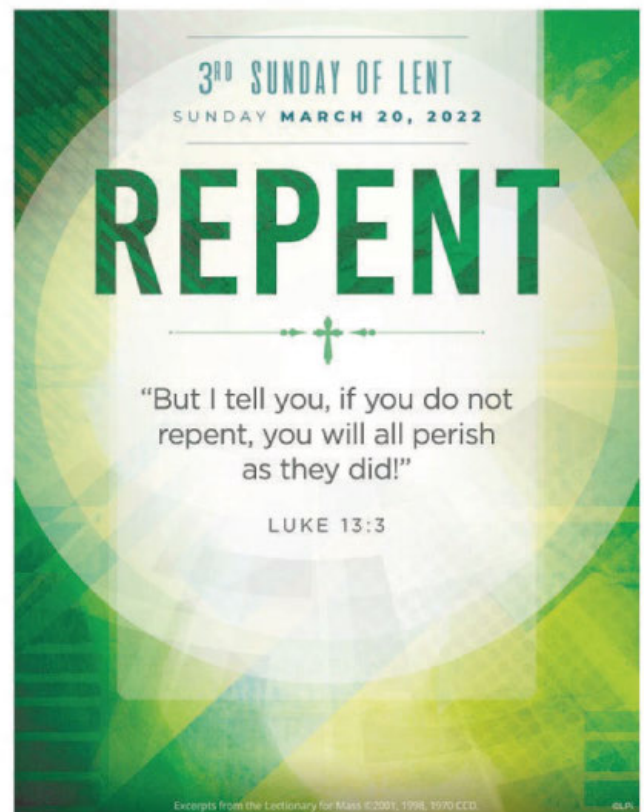
The Sacrament of Matrimony requires a time of spiritual, intellectual and emotional preparation. Couples should arrange with the Parish Office one (1) year prior to the wedding date. Please call the parish office for an appointment with the pastor prior to making any other wedding plans.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults:

Anyone who feels called by God to become a member of the Catholic Church participates in the RCIA Program. A series of instructions and liturgical ceremonies designed to give total formation in the Catholic Faith.

DOCUMENTO PREPARATORIO

7. No obstante nuestras infidelidades, el Espíritu continúa actuando en la historia y mostrando su potencia vivificante. Precisamente en los surcos excavados por los sufrimientos de todo tipo padecidos por la familia humana y por el Pueblo de Dios están floreciendo nuevos lenguajes de fe y nuevos caminos capaces, no sólo de interpretar los eventos desde un punto de vista teológico, sino también de encontrar en medio de las pruebas las razones para refundar el camino de la vida cristiana y eclesial. Es un motivo de gran esperanza que no pocas Iglesias hayan ya comenzado a organizar encuentros y procesos de consulta al Pueblo de Dios, más o menos estructurados. Allí donde tales procesos han sido organizados según un estilo sinodal, el sentido de Iglesia ha florecido y la participación de todos ha dado un nuevo impulso a la vida eclesial. Se confirman igualmente el deseo de protagonismo dentro de la Iglesia por parte de los jóvenes, y la solicitud de una mayor valoración de las mujeres y de espacios de participación en la misión de la Iglesia, ya señalados por las Asambleas sinodales de 2018 y de 2019. En esta misma línea se ha de considerar la reciente institución del ministerio laical de catequista y la apertura a las mujeres del acceso a los ministerios del lectorado y del acolitado.

274. The family is the first school of human values, where we learn the wise use of freedom. Certain inclinations develop in childhood and become so deeply rooted that they remain throughout life, either as attractions to a particular value or a natural repugnance to certain ways of acting. Many people think and act in a certain way because they deem it to be right on the basis of what they learned, as if by osmosis, from their earliest years: "That's how I was taught". "That's what I learned to do". In the family we can also learn to be critical about certain messages sent by the various media. Sad to say, some television programmes or forms of advertising often negatively influence and undercut the values inculcated in family life.

- Visit a friend or family member who is having a difficult time
 - Send someone a sympathy card or care package
 - On an anniversary of a friend or family member's miscarriage or loss of a child or spouse, remember them by calling, emailing or sending them a card
 - Offer words of encouragement to those who seem discouraged
 - Walk with others through their pain
 - Be present to those who are struggling or in emotional pain or despair
 - Give comfort to and care to those with sick loved ones

Bear Wrongs Patiently

- Strive to give others the benefit of the doubt
 - Pray to God for His help in carrying serious wrongs
 - Practice with little acts of patience so that you are prone to be patient when the bigger upsets of life come your way
 - Seek to be less critical yourself
 - "Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you"
 - Be mindful of the things that make you impatient
 - Before responding impatiently, take a deep breath and allow yourself to walk away
 - Put small annoyances into perspective and find the positives
- When waiting, use your unexpected extra time wisely by saying a brief prayer or praying the rosary.

Give Drink to the Thirsty

Pass out water bottles to people in need
Bring a bottle or glass of water to a neighbor working in your neighborhood
Donate baby formula to a local pregnancy aid center
Have a "donations only" lemonade stand and donate the funds to our local Catholic Charities or to Catholic Relief Services
Watch for ways to save on water and to keep it clean
Learn more about the issue of water by reading Pope Francis' Encyclical, *Laudato Si'* (Praise be to you)

MESSAGE OF THE HOLY FATHER for Lent 2022

In truth, we see only a small portion of the fruits of what we sow, since, according to the Gospel proverb, "one sows, while another reaps" (Jn 4:37). When we sow for the benefit of others, we share in God's own benevolent love: "it is truly noble to place our hope in the hidden power of the seeds of goodness we sow, and thus to initiate processes whose fruits will be reaped by others" (Fratelli Tutti, 196). Sowing goodness for the benefit of others frees us from narrow self-interest, infuses our actions with gratuitousness, and makes us part of the magnificent horizon of God's benevolent plan. The word of God broadens and elevates our vision: it tells us that the real harvest is eschatological, the harvest of the last, undying day. The mature fruit of our lives and actions is "fruit for eternal life" (Jn 4:36), our "treasure in heaven" (Lk 12:33; 18:22). Jesus himself uses the image of the seed that dies in the ground in order to bear fruit as a symbol of the mystery of his death and resurrection (cf. Jn 12:24); while Saint Paul uses the same image to speak of the resurrection of our bodies: "What is sown is perishable, but what is raised is imperishable; what is sown is contemptible but what is raised is glorious; what is sown is weak, but what is raised is powerful; what is sown is a natural body, and what is raised is a spiritual body" (1 Cor 15:42-44). The hope of resurrection is the great light that the risen Christ brings to the world, for "if our hope in Christ has been for this life only, we are of all people the most pitiable. In fact, however, Christ has been raised from the dead, as the first-fruits of all who have fallen asleep" (1 Cor 15:19-20). Those who are intimately united to him in love "by dying a death like his" (Rom 6:5) will also be united to his resurrection for eternal life (cf. Jn 5:29). "Then the upright will shine like the sun in the kingdom of their Father" (Mt 13:43).

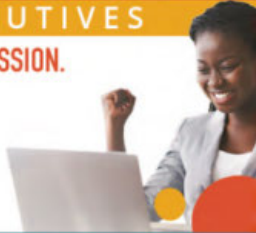

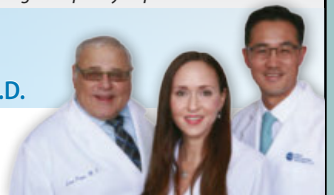
