Active membership is determined by registration, faithful participation and giving of one's time, talent and resources to this community of faith. **The parish cannot issue certificates of eligibility for sacramental sponsorship, give recommendations or character references if a person is not an active parishioner.**

The Sacrament of Baptism:

Baptism is the celebration through which a child is brought into the faith of the Catholic Church. Parents must be registered and practicing members of the parish. Parents and sponsors are required to attend a pre-baptismal class. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics in good standing and able to obtain a certificate of eligibility from their parish.

Sacrament of Matrimony:

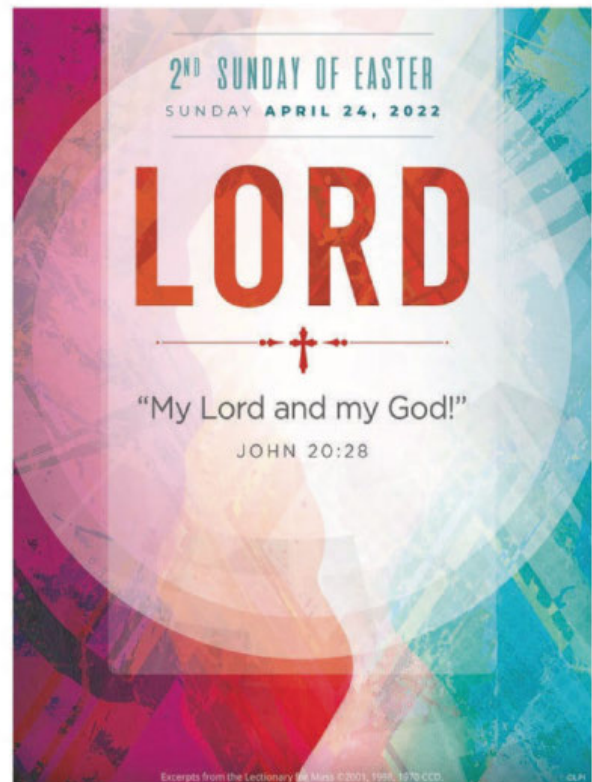
The Sacrament of Matrimony requires a time of spiritual, intellectual and emotional preparation. Couples should arrange with the Parish Office one (1) year prior to the wedding date. Please call the parish office for an appointment with the pastor prior to making any other wedding plans.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults:

Anyone who feels called by God to become a member of the Catholic Church participates in the RCIA Program. A series of instructions and liturgical ceremonies designed to give total formation in the Catholic Faith.

Pastoral Care of the Sick:

Any parishioner who is sick, aged or incapacitated may receive the Eucharist at home. Please contact the Parish Office to have a priest visit you at home or in the hospital.

Divine Mercy Sunday

Each year, on the Second Sunday of Easter, the Church celebrates the Sunday of Divine Mercy. In the 1930s, Jesus chose a humble Polish nun, St. Maria Faustina Kowalska, to receive private revelations concerning His Divine Mercy that were recorded in her *Diary*. St. Faustina's *Diary* records 14 occasions when Jesus requested that a Feast of Mercy be observed. On one such occasion, Jesus said to St. Faustina: *"My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the Fount of My Mercy"* (Diary 699). On May 5, 2000, five days after the canonization of St. Faustina, the Vatican decreed that the Second Sunday of Easter would henceforth be known as the Sunday of Divine Mercy. God's greatest desire is to forgive us, pouring out His infinite mercy upon us so that we may be *healed*.

DOCUMENTO PREPARATORIO**

12. A este dinamismo de la Tradición se ha anclado el Concilio Vaticano II. Esto demuestra que «fue voluntad de Dios el santificar y salvar a los hombres, no aisladamente, sin conexión alguna de unos con otros, sino constituyendo un pueblo, que le confesara en verdad y le sirviera santamente» (LG, n. 9). Los miembros del Pueblo de Dios están unidos por el Bautismo y «aun cuando algunos, por voluntad de Cristo, han sido constituidos doctores, dispensadores de los misterios y pastores para los demás, existe una auténtica igualdad entre todos en cuanto a la dignidad y a la acción común a todos los Fieles en orden a la edificación del Cuerpo de Cristo» (LG, n. 32). Por lo tanto, todos los Bautizados, al participar de la función sacerdotal, profética y real de Cristo, «en el ejercicio de la sacramento, profética y riqueza de sus carismas, de su vocación, de sus ministerios»¹⁵, son sujetos activos de evangelización, tanto singularmente como formando parte integral del Pueblo de Dios.

Amoris: Family life as an educational setting

279. Nor is it good for parents to be domineering. When children are made to feel that only their parents can be trusted, this hinders an adequate process of socialization and growth in affective maturity. To help expand the parental relationship to broader realities, "Christian communities are called to offer support to the educational mission of families",²⁹⁷ particularly through the catechesis associated with Christian initiation. To foster an integral education, we need to "renew the covenant between the family and the Christian community".²⁹⁸ The Synod wanted to emphasize the importance of Catholic schools which "play a vital role in assisting parents in their duty to raise their children... Catholic schools should be encouraged in their mission to help pupils grow into mature adults who can view the world with the love of Jesus and who can understand life as a call to serve God".²⁹⁹ For this reason, "the Church strongly affirms her freedom to set forth her teaching and the right of conscientious objection on the part of educators".

The "40 Days of Lent, 40 Items for Almsgiving" effort was a great success. Just wanted to tell you how impressed we were seeing the great generosity of our parishioners. Thirteen bags of new clothes and toiletry items were delivered to the Veterans Hospital in Menlo Park, several containers were for Ozanam Shelter and another shelter in Edison, and St. Vincent de Paul received a huge assortment of food and other items to distribute to the needy. 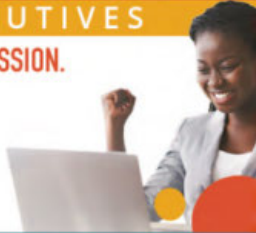

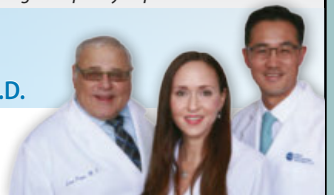
