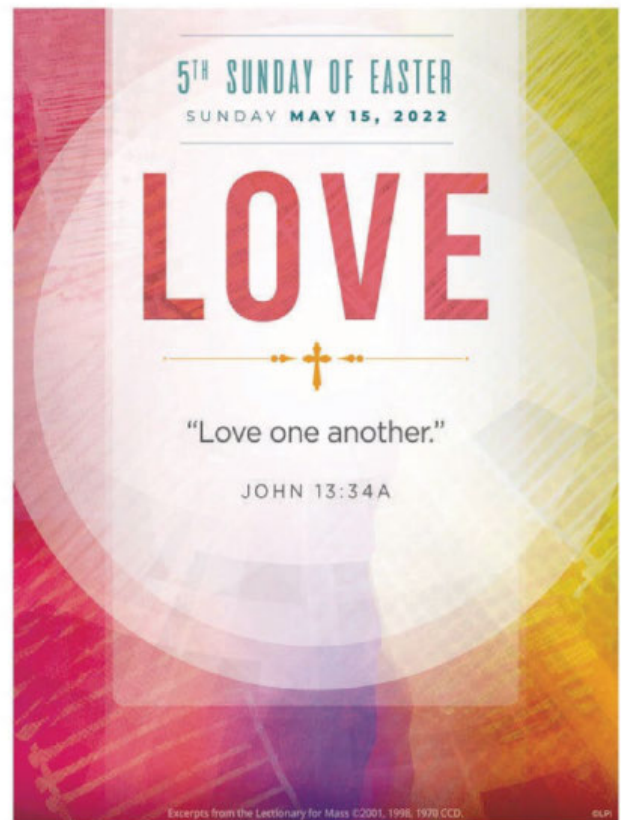
The Sacrament of Baptism:

Baptism is the celebration through which a child is brought into the faith of the Catholic Church. Parents must be registered and practicing members of the parish. Parents and sponsors are required to attend a pre-baptismal class. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics in good standing and able to obtain a certificate of eligibility from their parish.

Sacrament of Matrimony: The Sacrament of Matrimony requires a time of spiritual, intellectual and emotional preparation. Couples should arrange with the Parish Office one (1) year prior to the wedding date. Please call the parish office for an appointment with the pastor prior to making any other wedding plans.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: Anyone who feels called by God to become a member of the Catholic Church participates in the RCIA Program. A series of instructions and liturgical ceremonies designed to give total formation in the Catholic Faith.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: Any parishioner who is sick, aged or incapacitated may receive the Eucharist at home. Please contact the Parish Office to have a priest visit you at home or in the hospital.

Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord

Effective this upcoming Easter season, the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord will be permanently transferred from Thursday of the Sixth Week of Easter to the following Sunday, the Seventh Sunday of Easter, in all Catholic dioceses in New Jersey. This year, the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord will be observed on Sunday, May 29. This liturgical observance is an integral dimension of the completion of Our Lord's paschal mystery and, after much discussion, the Catholic Bishops of New Jersey collectively discerned that the transferring the observance to the following Sunday would allow for greater participation among the faithful.

Sinodo 2021 –2013: Por Una Iglesia Sinodal
DOCUMENTO PREPARATORIO

15. El sentido del camino al cual todos estamos llamados consiste, principalmente, en descubrir el rostro y la forma de una Iglesia sinodal, en la que «cada uno tiene algo que aprender. Pueblo fiel, Colegio episcopal, Obispo de Roma: uno en escucha de los otros; y todos en escucha del Espíritu Santo, el "Espíritu de verdad" (Jn 14,17), para conocer lo que Él "dice a las Iglesias" (Ap 2,7)»¹⁹. El Obispo de Roma, en cuanto principio y fundamento de la unidad de la Iglesia, pide a todos los Obispos y a todas las Iglesias particulares, en las cuales y a partir de las cuales existe la Iglesia católica, una y única (cf. LG, n. 23), que entren con confianza y audacia en el camino de la sinodalidad. En este "caminar juntos", pedimos al Espíritu que nos ayude a descubrir cómo la comunión, que compone en la unidad la variedad de los dones, de los carismas y de los ministerios, es para la misión: una Iglesia sinodal es una Iglesia "en salida", una Iglesia misionera, «con las puertas abiertas» (EG, n. 46). Esto incluye la llamada a profundizar las relaciones con las otras Iglesias y comunidades cristianas, con las que estamos unidos por el único Bautismo. La perspectiva del "caminar juntos", además, es todavía más amplia, y abraza a toda la humanidad, con que compartimos «los gozos y las esperanzas, las tristezas y las angustias» (GS, n. 1). Una Iglesia sinodal es un signo profético sobre todo para una comunidad de las naciones incapaz de proponer un proyecto compartido, a través del cual conseguir el bien de todos: practicar la sinodalidad es hoy para la Iglesia el modo más evidente de ser «sacramento universal de salvación» (LG, n. 48), «signo e instrumento de la unión íntima con Dios y de la unidad de todo el género humano» (LG, n. 1).

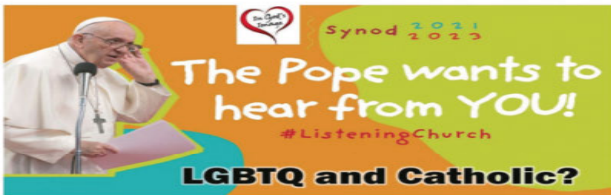

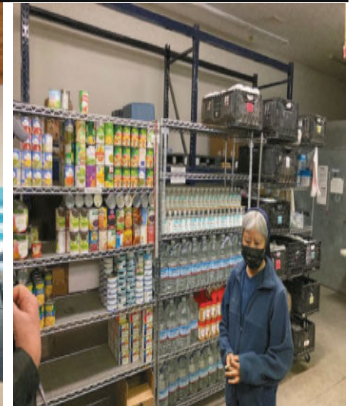

Relics of Saint Bernadette

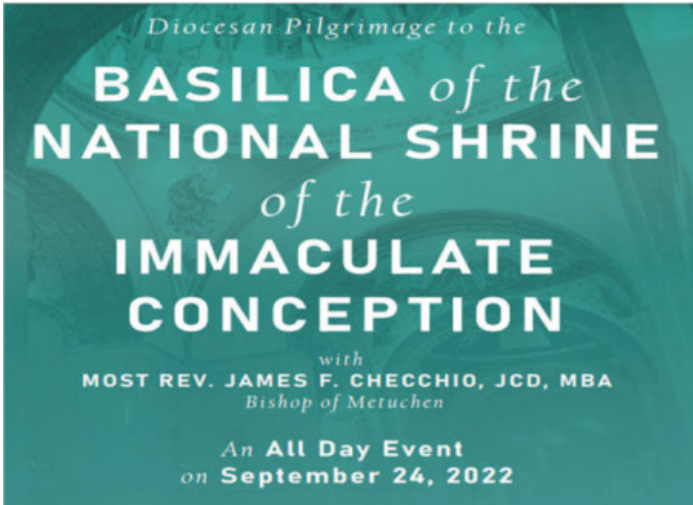

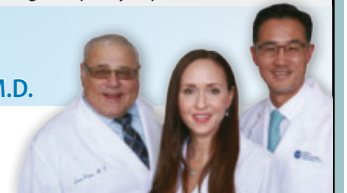

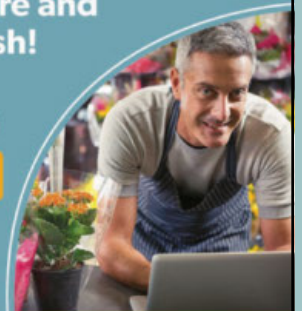
