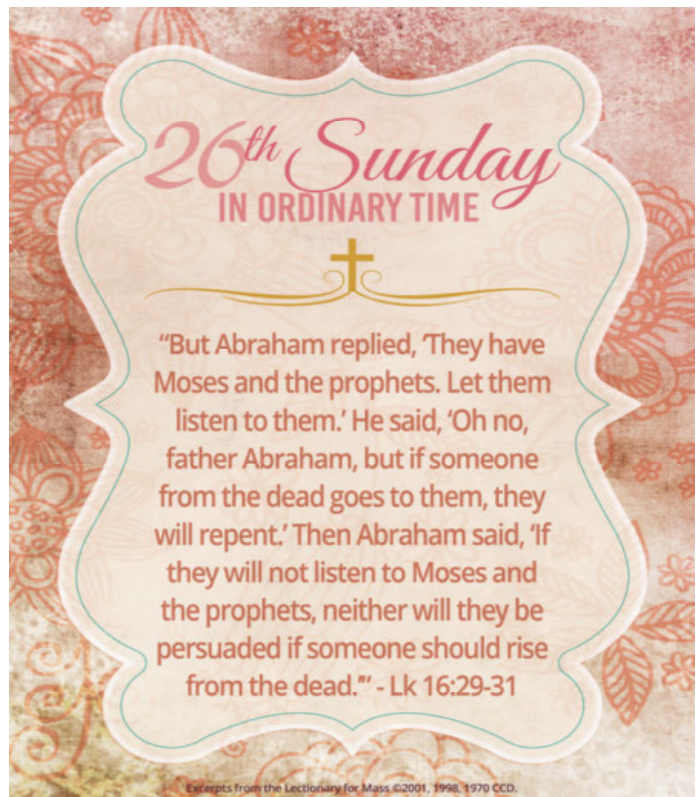
### **The Sacrament of Baptism:**

Baptism is the celebration through which a child is brought into the faith of the Catholic Church. Parents must be registered and practicing members of the parish. Parents and sponsors are required to attend a pre-baptismal class. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics in good standing and able to obtain a certificate of eligibility from their parish.

**Sacrament of Matrimony:** The Sacrament of Matrimony requires a time of spiritual, intellectual and emotional preparation. Couples should arrange with the Parish Office one (1) year prior to the wedding date. Please call the parish office for an appointment with the pastor prior to making any other wedding plans.

**Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults:** Anyone who feels called by God to become a member of the Catholic Church participates in the RCIA Program. A series of instructions and liturgical ceremonies designed to give total formation in the Catholic Faith.

**Pastoral Care of the Sick:** Any parishioner who is sick, aged or incapacitated may receive the Eucharist at home. Please contact the Parish Office to have a priest visit you at home or in the hospital.

## SYNTHESIS OF THE SYNOD ON SYNODALITY

The Roman Catholic Diocese of Metuchen New Jersey

October 2021 - June 2022

### REFLECTION QUESTIONS

**Core Question 1: Called to Listen – How does God speak to you through those in your parish and others in your life?**

Participants explained that they hear God speak to them through the Sacred Scriptures, the priest's homily, the Sacraments and through those who serve in support ministries such as bereavement groups. God also speaks to them through the letters and video messages from Bishop Checchio. Participants conveyed that they hear God speak through the actions of holy people and there is a need for more lay witnesses of the faith.

The synod process, itself, is one of active listening and those who participated appreciated the opportunity to have small group, spiritual conversations, while listening for the voice of the Holy Spirit.

There is a need for more hospitality for newcomers and for those from different cultures. There is an overall feeling that parishes do not provide space for listening to those who are marginalized or are socially excluded. "A voice in need knows no conditions."

Concerns were also expressed that the institutional Church is losing younger members who may claim to be spiritual but do not want to identify with an institutional church. The youth appear to be interested in service as a way of expressing their faith but little is being done to encourage them to commit themselves to the Catholic community, which they see as very law-bound rather than caring and pastoral.

The discussion revealed two opposing positions with one group pushing for change while others insisting on more traditional perspectives (those who prefer the Latin Mass, for example).

### St. Vincent de Paul Food Pantry

Guardian Angels operates a year-round food pantry in the parish hall. This service is held every other Wednesday morning from 9:30-11:30AM and is open for those in need. We encourage you to mention this to anyone you know, in or out of our parish, in the Highland Park or Edison Township area who are experiencing difficulty and hardship during these times to take advantage of this community service.

As a reminder donations in the form of non-perishable food items can be dropped off at our churches or in the breezeway. You can also drop off items to the food pantry during the operating times. Monetary contributions are welcomed and can be placed in an envelope marked food pantry. Please place the envelope in the collections basket during mass. Thank you for your assistance with this.

**Sinodo 2021-23**

**La pregunta fundamental: Para contribuir a la consultación**

**31.** El objetivo de la primera fase del camino sinodal es favorecer un amplio proceso de consulta para recoger la riqueza de las experiencias de sinodalidad vividas, con sus diferentes articulaciones y matices, implicando a los pastores y a los fieles de las Iglesias particulares a en todos los diversos niveles, a través de medios más adecuados según las específicas realidades locales: la consulta, coordinada por el obispo, está dirigida «a los presbíteros, a los diáconos y a los fieles laicos de sus Iglesias, tanto individualmente como asociados, sin descuidar las preciosas aportaciones que pueden venir de los Consagrados y Consagradas» (EC, n. 7). De modo particular se pide la aportación de los organismos de participación de las Iglesias particulares, especialmente el Consejo presbiteral y el Consejo pastoral, a partir de los cuales verdaderamente «puede comenzar a tomar forma una Iglesia sinodal»<sup>22</sup>. Será igualmente valiosa la contribución de las otras realidades eclesiales a las que se enviará el Documento Preparatorio, como también de aquellos que deseen enviar directamente su propia aportación. Finalmente, será de fundamental importancia que encuentre espacio también la voz de los pobres y de los excluidos, no solamente de quien tiene algún rol o responsabilidad dentro de las Iglesias **p a r t i c u l a r e s**.

**32.** La síntesis, que cada una de las Iglesias particulares elaborará al final de este trabajo de escucha y discernimiento, constituirá su aportación al camino de la Iglesia universal. Para hacer más fáciles y sostenibles las fases sucesivas del camino, es importante tratar de condensar los frutos de la oración y de la reflexión en una síntesis de unas diez páginas al máximo. Si fuera necesario para contextualizarlas o explicarlas mejor, se podrán adjuntar otros textos como anexos. Recordamos que la finalidad del Sinodo, y por lo tanto de esta consulta, no es producir documentos, sino «hacer que germinen sueños, suscitar profecías y visiones, hacer florecer esperanzas, estimular la confianza, vendar heridas, entretejer relaciones, resucitar una aurora de esperanza, aprender unos de otros, y crear un imaginario positivo que ilumine las mentes, enardezca los corazones, dé fuerza a las manos».

**Amoris Laetitia: Mitigating factors in pastoral discernment**

**302.** The Catechism of the Catholic Church clearly mentions these factors: "imputability and responsibility for an action can be diminished or even nullified by ignorance, inadvertence, duress, fear, habit, inordinate attachments, and other psychological or social factors". In another paragraph, the Catechism refers once again to circumstances which mitigate moral responsibility, and mentions at length "affective immaturity, force of acquired habit, conditions of anxiety or other psychological or social factors that lessen or even extenuate moral culpability". For this reason, a negative judgment about an objective situation does not imply a judgment about the imputability or culpability of the person involved. On the basis of these convictions, I consider very fitting what many Synod Fathers wanted to affirm: "Under certain circumstances people find it very difficult to act differently. Therefore, while upholding a general rule, it is necessary to recognize that responsibility with respect to certain actions or decisions is not the same in all cases. Pastoral discernment, while taking into account a person's properly formed conscience, must take responsibility for these situations. Even the consequences of actions taken are not necessarily the same in all cases".

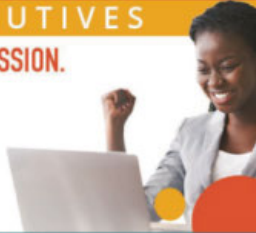

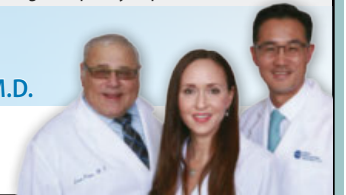
