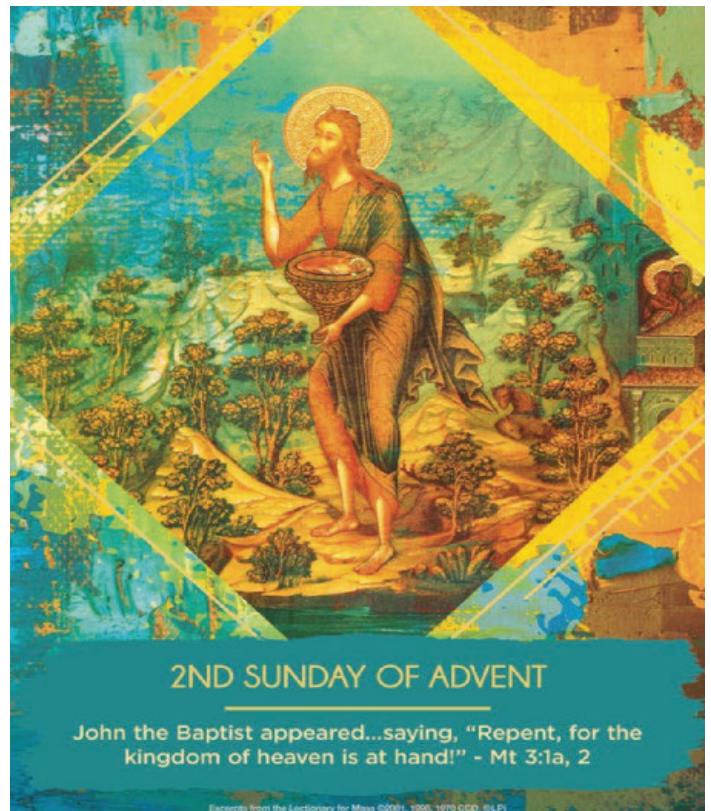
The Sacrament of Baptism:

Baptism is the celebration through which a child is brought into the faith of the Catholic Church. Parents must be registered and practicing members of the parish. Parents and sponsors are required to attend a pre-baptismal class. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics in good standing and able to obtain a certificate of eligibility from their parish.

Sacrament of Matrimony: The Sacrament of Matrimony requires a time of spiritual, intellectual and emotional preparation. Couples should arrange with the Parish Office one (1) year prior to the wedding date. Please call the parish office for an appointment with the pastor prior to making any other wedding plans.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: Anyone who feels called by God to become a member of the Catholic Church participates in the RCIA Program. A series of instructions and liturgical ceremonies designed to give total formation in the Catholic Faith.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: Any parishioner who is sick, aged or incapacitated may receive the Eucharist at home. Please contact the Parish Office to have a priest visit you at home or in the hospital.

CONCELEBRACIÓN EUCARÍSTICA

HOMILÍA DEL SANTO PADRE

Nos reúne en torno a su mesa el Señor, haciéndose pan por nosotros: «Es el pan de la fiesta sobre la mesa de los hijos, [...] crea compartición, refuerza los vínculos, tiene sabor de comunión» (*Himno XXVII Congreso Eucarístico Nacional, Matera 2022*). Sin embargo, el Evangelio que acabamos de escuchar nos dice que no siempre en la mesa del mundo el pan es compartido: esto es verdad; no siempre emana el perfume de la comunión; no siempre es partido en la justicia. Nos hace bien pararnos delante de la escena dramática descrita por Jesús en esta parábola que hemos escuchado: por un lado un rico vestido de púrpura y de lino fino, haciendo alarde de su opulencia y festejando lujosamente; por otro lado, un pobre, cubierto de llagas, que yace en la puerta esperando que de esa mesa caiga alguna migaja con la que alimentarse. Y frente a esta contradicción —que vemos todos los días—, ante de esta contradicción nos preguntamos: ¿a qué nos invita el sacramento de la Eucaristía, fuente y culmen de la vida del cristiano? En primer lugar, la Eucaristía nos recuerda *el primado de Dios*. El rico de la parábola no está abierto a la relación con Dios: piensa solo en el propio bienestar, en satisfacer sus necesidades, en disfrutar la vida. Y con esto ha perdido también el nombre. El Evangelio no dice cómo se llamaba: lo nombra con el adjetivo “un rico”, en cambio, del pobre dice el nombre: Lázaro. Las riquezas te llevan a esto, te despojan también del nombre. Satisfecho de sí, emborrachado por el dinero, aturdido por la feria de las vanidades, no hay lugar para Dios en su vida porque sólo se adora a sí mismo. No es casualidad que de él no se diga el nombre: lo llamamos “rico”, lo definimos solo con un adjetivo porque ya ha perdido su nombre, ha perdido su identidad que viene dada solo por los bienes que posee. Qué triste también hoy esta realidad, cuando confundimos lo que somos con lo que tenemos, cuando juzgamos a las personas por la riqueza que tienen, por los títulos que exhiben, por los roles que cubren o por la marca del vestido que usan. Es la *religión del tener y aparentar*, que a menudo domina la escena de este mundo, pero que al final nos deja con las manos vacías: siempre. A este rico del Evangelio, de hecho, no le ha quedado ni el nombre. Ya no es nadie. Al contrario, el pobre tiene un nombre, Lázaro, que significa “Dios ayuda”. Incluso en su condición de pobreza y de marginación, él puede conservar íntegra su dignidad porque vive en la relación con Dios. En su mismo nombre hay algo de Dios y Dios es la esperanza inquebrantable de su vida.

Amoris Laetitia: The logic of pastoral mercy

311. The teaching of moral theology should not fail to incorporate these considerations, for although it is quite true that concern must be shown for the integrity of the Church’s moral teaching, special care should always be shown to emphasize and encourage the highest and most central values of the Gospel,³⁶³ particularly the primacy of charity as a response to the completely gratuitous offer of God’s love. At times we find it hard to make room for God’s unconditional love in our pastoral activity.³⁶⁴ We put so many conditions on mercy that we empty it of its concrete meaning and real significance. That is the worst way of watering down the Gospel. It is true, for example, that mercy does not exclude justice and truth, but first and foremost we have to say that mercy is the fullness of justice and the most radiant manifestation of God’s truth. For this reason, we should always consider “inadequate any theological conception which in the end puts in doubt the omnipotence of God and, especially, his mercy”.

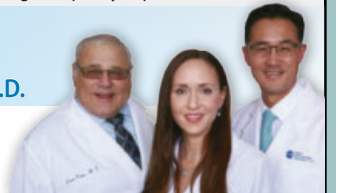
