**Parish Membership:** We welcome new members to our Parish family and request you register in the Parish as soon as possible. Active membership is determined by registration, faithful participation and giving of one's time, talent and resources to this community of faith. **The parish cannot issue certificates of eligibility for sacramental sponsorship, give recommendations or character references if a person is not an active parishioner.**

### **The Sacrament of Baptism:**

Baptism is the celebration through which a child is brought into the faith of the Catholic Church. Parents must be registered and practicing members of the parish. Parents and sponsors are required to attend a pre-baptismal class. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics in good standing and able to obtain a certificate of eligibility from their parish.

**Sacrament of Matrimony:** The Sacrament of Matrimony requires a time of spiritual, intellectual and emotional preparation. Couples should arrange with the Parish Office one (1) year prior to the wedding date. Please call the parish office for an appointment with the pastor prior to making any other wedding plans.

**Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults:** Anyone who feels called by God to become a member of the Catholic Church participates in the RCIA Program. A series of instructions and liturgical ceremonies designed to give total formation in the Catholic Faith.

**Pastoral Care of the Sick:** Any parishioner who is sick, aged or incapacitated may receive the Eucharist at home. Please contact the Parish Office to have a priest visit you at home or in the hospital.

## Apostolic Letter by Pope Francis, 30 September 2019,

### Instituting the Sunday of the Word of God

At the conclusion of the Extraordinary Jubilee of Mercy, I proposed setting aside “a Sunday given over entirely to the word of God, so as to appreciate the inexhaustible riches contained in that constant dialogue between the Lord and his people” (*Misericordia et Misera*, 7). Devoting a specific Sunday of the liturgical year to the word of God can enable the Church to experience anew how the risen Lord opens up for us the treasury of his word and enables us to proclaim its unfathomable riches before the world. Here, we are reminded of the teaching of Saint Ephrem: “Who is able to understand, Lord, all the richness of even one of your words? There is more that eludes us than what we can understand. We are like the thirsty drinking from a fountain. Your word has as many aspects as the perspectives of those who study it. The Lord has colored his word with diverse beauties, so that those who study it can contemplate what stirs them. He has hidden in his word all treasures, so that each of us may find a richness in what he or she contemplates” (*Commentary on the Diatessaron*, 1, 18). ... Consequently, I hereby declare that the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time is to be devoted to the celebration, study and dissemination of the word of God. This *Sunday of the Word of God* will thus be a fitting part of that time of the year when we are encouraged to strengthen our bonds with the Jewish people and to pray for Christian unity. This is more than a temporal coincidence: the celebration of the *Sunday of the Word of God* has ecumenical value, since the Scriptures point out, for those who listen, the path to authentic and firm unity.

### The Gospel According to Matthew

The position of the Gospel according to Matthew as the first of the four gospels in the New Testament reflects both the view that it was the first to be written, a view that goes back to the late second century A.D., and the esteem in which it was held by the church; no other was so frequently quoted in the no canonical literature of earliest Christianity. Although the majority of scholars now reject the opinion about the time of its composition, the high estimation of this work remains. The reason for that becomes clear upon study of the way in which Matthew presents his story of Jesus, the demands of Christian discipleship, and the breaking-in of the new and final age through the ministry but particularly through the death and resurrection of Jesus. **Carta Apostólica Del Santo Padre Francisco con la que se instituye el Domingo de la Palabra de Dios**

Tras la conclusión del *Jubileo extraordinario de la misericordia*, pedí que se pensara en «un domingo completamente dedicado a la Palabra de Dios, para comprender la riqueza inagotable que proviene de ese diálogo constante de Dios con su pueblo» (Carta ap. *Misericordia et misera*, 7). Dedicar concretamente un domingo del Año litúrgico a la Palabra de Dios nos permite, sobre todo, hacer que la Iglesia reviva el gesto del Resucitado que abre también para nosotros el tesoro de su Palabra para que podamos anunciar por todo el mundo esta riqueza inagotable. En este sentido, me vienen a la memoria las enseñanzas de san Efrén: «¿Quién es capaz, Señor, de penetrar con su mente una sola de tus frases? Como el sediento que bebe de la fuente, mucho más es lo que dejamos que lo que tomamos. Porque la palabra del Señor presenta muy diversos aspectos, según la diversa capacidad de los que la estudian. El Señor pintó con multiplicidad de colores su palabra, para que todo el que la estudie pueda ver en ella lo que más le plazca. Escondió en su palabra variedad de tesoros, para que cada uno de nosotros pudiera enriquecerse en cualquiera de los puntos en que concentrar su reflexión» (*Comentarios sobre el Diatearón*, 1,18).

Así pues, establezco que el III Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario esté dedicado a la celebración, reflexión y divulgación de la Palabra de Dios. Este *Domingo de la Palabra de Dios* se colocará en un momento oportuno de ese periodo del año, en el que estamos invitados a fortalecer los lazos con los judíos y a rezar por la unidad de los cristianos. No se trata de una mera coincidencia temporal: celebrar el *Domingo de la Palabra de Dios* expresa un valor ecuménico, porque la Sagrada Escritura indica a los que se ponen en actitud de escucha el camino a seguir para llegar a una auténtica y sólida unidad.

**SANTA MISA EN LA SOLEMNIDAD DE LA EPIFANÍA DEL SEÑOR**

**HOMILÍA DEL SANTO PADRE FRANCISCO**  
**Viernes, 6 de Enero de 2023**

**Continuación del Domingo, 15 de Enero de 2023.....**

Es en estos momentos que surgen de nuestro corazón las preguntas irreprimibles, que nos abren a la búsqueda de Dios: ¿Dónde está la felicidad para mí? ¿Dónde está la vida plena a la que aspiro? ¿Dónde se encuentra ese amor que no pasa, que no tiene ocaso, que no se rompe ni siquiera ante la fragilidad, los fracasos o las traiciones? ¿Cuáles son las oportunidades escondidas dentro de mis crisis y mis sufrimientos?

Pero sucede que el clima que respiramos cada día ofrece “tranquilizantes del alma”, sustitutos para sedar, para sedar nuestra inquietud y apagar esas preguntas, desde los productos del consumismo a las seducciones del placer, desde los debates sensacionalistas hasta la idolatría del bienestar; todo parece decirnos: no pienses mucho, deja que pasen, disfruta la vida. Frecuentemente buscamos acomodar el corazón en la caja fuerte de la comodidad —acomodar el corazón en la caja fuerte de la comodidad—, pero si los Magos hubiesen hecho esto no habrían encontrado nunca al Señor. Este es el peligro, sedar el corazón, sedar el alma para que ya no haya inquietud. Dios, sin embargo, vive en nuestras preguntas inquietas; en ellas nosotros «lo buscamos como la noche busca a la aurora [...]». Él está en el silencio que nos turba ante la muerte y al final de toda grandeza humana; está en la necesidad de justicia y de amor que llevamos dentro; es el Misterio santo del Totalmente Otro, nostalgia de justicia perfecta y consumada, de reconciliación, de paz» (C.M. Martini, *El jardín interior. Un camino para creyentes y no creyentes*, Santander 2017, 26). Por tanto, este es el primer lugar: la inquietud de las preguntas. No tengamos miedo de entrar en esta inquietud de las preguntas, son precisamente los caminos que nos llevan a Jesús.

**Amoris Laetitia: Gathered in prayer in the light of Easter 319.** Marriage is also the experience of belonging completely to another person. Spouses accept the challenge and aspiration of supporting one another, growing old together, and in this way reflecting God’s own faithfulness. This firm decision, which shapes a style of life, is an “interior requirement of the covenant of conjugal love”,<sup>380</sup> since “a person who cannot choose to love for ever can hardly love for even a single day”.<sup>381</sup> At the same time, such fidelity would be spiritually meaningless were it simply a matter of following a law with obedient resignation. Rather, it is a matter of the heart, into which God alone sees (cf. Mt 5:28). Every morning, on rising, we reaffirm before God our decision to be faithful, come what may in the course of the day. And all of us, before going to sleep, hope to wake up and continue this adventure, trusting in the Lord’s help. In this way, each spouse is for the other a sign and instrument of the closeness of the Lord, who never abandons us: “Lo, I am with you always, to the close of the age” (Mt 28:20).

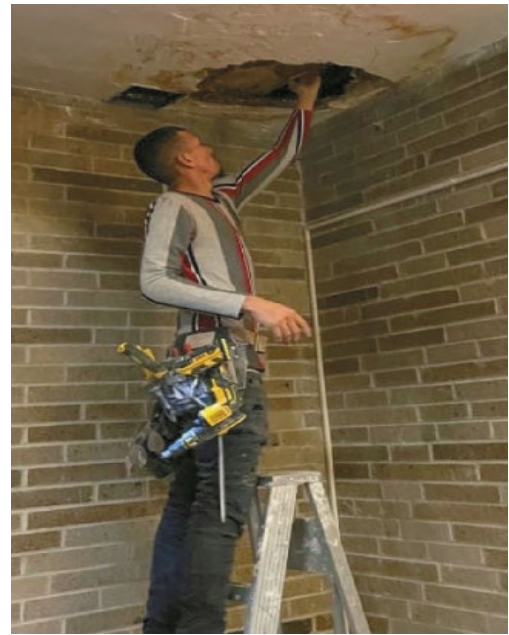

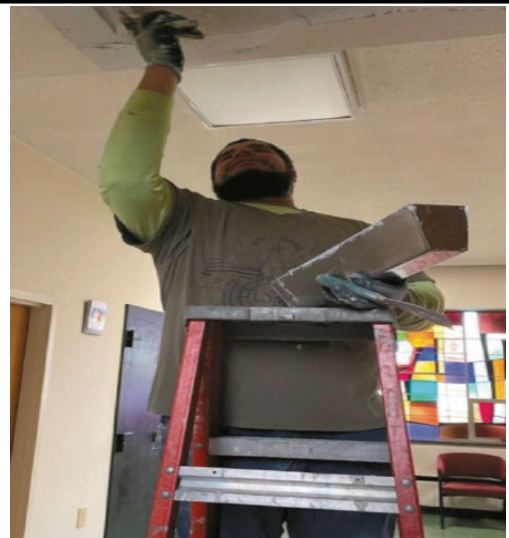
**International Week of Prayer for Christian Unity**

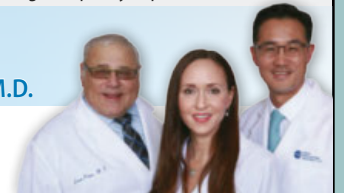
