Active membership is determined by registration, faithful participation and giving of one's time, talent and resources to this community of faith. **The parish cannot issue certificates of eligibility for sacramental sponsorship, give recommendations or character references if a person is not an active parishioner.**

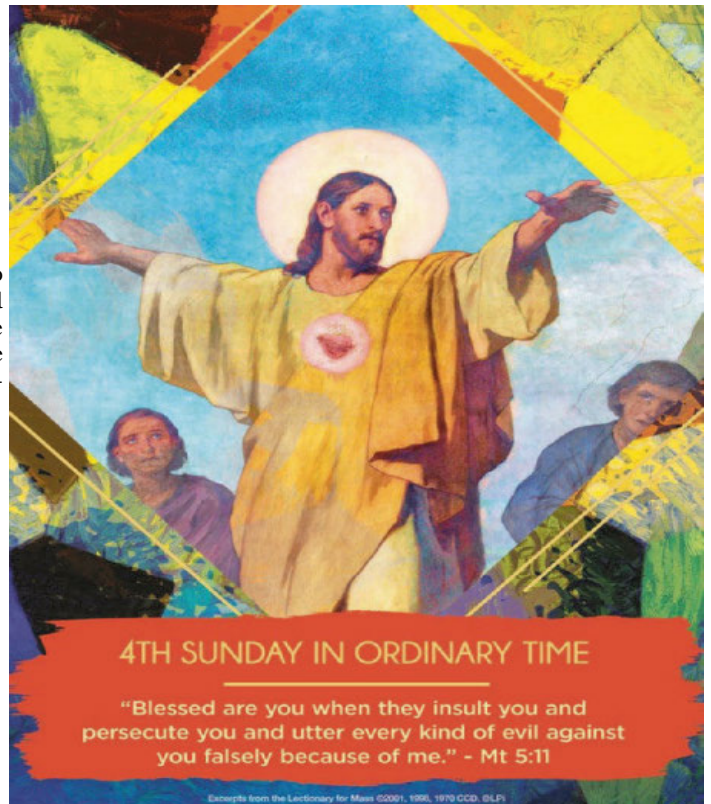
#### **The Sacrament of Baptism:**

Baptism is the celebration through which a child is brought into the faith of the Catholic Church. Parents must be registered and practicing members of the parish. Parents and sponsors are required to attend a pre-baptismal class. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics in good standing and able to obtain a certificate of eligibility from their parish.

**Sacrament of Matrimony:** The Sacrament of Matrimony requires a time of spiritual, intellectual and emotional preparation. Couples should arrange with the Parish Office one (1) year prior to the wedding date. Please call the parish office for an appointment with the pastor prior to making any other wedding plans.

**Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults:** Anyone who feels called by God to become a member of the Catholic Church participates in the RCIA Program. A series of instructions and liturgical ceremonies designed to give total formation in the Catholic Faith.

**Pastoral Care of the Sick:** Any parishioner who is sick, aged or incapacitated may receive the Eucharist at home. Please contact the Parish Office to have a priest visit you at home or in the hospital.

Dear Brothers,

**SANTA MISA EN LA SOLEMNIDAD DE LA EPIFANÍA DEL SEÑOR**

**HOMILÍA DEL SANTO PADRE FRANCISCO**  
**Viernes, 6 de Enero de 2023**

**Continuación del Domingo, 15 de Enero de 2023.....**

Es en estos momentos que surgen de nuestro corazón las preguntas irreprimibles, que nos abren a la búsqueda de Dios: ¿Dónde está la felicidad para mí? ¿Dónde está la vida plena a la que aspiro? ¿Dónde se encuentra ese amor que no pasa, que no tiene ocaso, que no se rompe ni siquiera ante la fragilidad, los fracasos o las traiciones? ¿Cuáles son las oportunidades escondidas dentro de mis crisis y mis sufrimientos?

Pero sucede que el clima que respiramos cada día ofrece “tranquilizantes del alma”, sustitutos para sedar, para sedar nuestra inquietud y apagar esas preguntas, desde los productos del consumismo a las seducciones del placer, desde los debates sensacionalistas hasta la idolatría del bienestar; todo parece decirnos: no pienses mucho, deja que pasen, disfruta la vida. Frecuentemente buscamos acomodar el corazón en la caja fuerte de la comodidad —acomodar el corazón en la caja fuerte de la comodidad—, pero si los Magos hubiesen hecho esto no habrían encontrado nunca al Señor. Este es el peligro, sedar el corazón, sedar el alma para que ya no haya inquietud. Dios, sin embargo, vive en nuestras preguntas inquietas; en ellas nosotros «lo buscamos como la noche busca a la aurora [...]. Él está en el silencio que nos turba ante la muerte y al final de toda grandeza humana; está en la necesidad de justicia y de amor que llevamos dentro; es el Misterio santo del Totalmente Otro, nostalgia de justicia perfecta y consumada, de reconciliación, de paz» (C.M. Martini, *El jardín interior. Un camino para creyentes y no creyentes*, Santander 2017, 26). Por tanto, este es el primer lugar: la inquietud de las preguntas. No tengamos miedo de entrar en esta inquietud de las preguntas, son precisamente los caminos que nos llevan a Jesús.

**Amoris Laetitia: A spirituality of exclusive and free love**  
**320.** There comes a point where a couple's love attains the height of its freedom and becomes the basis of a healthy autonomy. This happens when each spouse realizes that the other is not his or her own, but has a much more important master, the one Lord. No one but God can presume to take over the deepest and most personal core of the loved one; he alone can be the ultimate center of their life. At the same time, the principle of spiritual realism requires that one spouse not presume that the other can completely satisfy his or her needs. The spiritual journey of each – as Dietrich Bonhoeffer nicely put it – needs to help them to a certain “disillusionment” with regard to the other,<sup>382</sup> to stop expecting from that person something which is proper to the love of God alone. This demands an interior divestment. The space which each of the spouses makes exclusively for their personal relationship with God not only helps heal the hurts of life in common, but also enables the spouses to find in the love of God the deepest source of meaning in their own lives. Each day we have to invoke the help of the Holy Spirit to make this interior freedom possible.

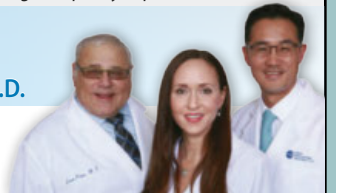
