Parish Membership: We welcome new members to our Parish family and request you register in the Parish as soon as possible. Active membership is determined by registration, faithful participation and giving of one's time, talent and resources to this community of faith. **The parish cannot issue certificates of eligibility for sacramental sponsorship, give recommendations or character references if a person is not an active parishioner.**

The Sacrament of Baptism:

Baptism is the celebration through which a child is brought into the faith of the Catholic Church. Parents must be registered and practicing members of the parish. Parents and sponsors are required to attend a pre-baptismal class. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics in good standing and able to obtain a certificate of eligibility from their parish.

Sacrament of Matrimony: The Sacrament of Matrimony requires a time of spiritual, intellectual and emotional preparation. Couples should arrange with the Parish Office one (1) year prior to the wedding date. Please call the parish office for an appointment with the pastor prior to making any other wedding plans.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: Anyone who feels called by God to become a member of the Catholic Church participates in the RCIA Program. A series of instructions and liturgical ceremonies designed to give total formation in the Catholic Faith.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: Any parishioner who is sick, aged or incapacitated may receive the Eucharist at home. Please contact the Parish Office to have a priest visit you at home or in the hospital.

Earthquake Relief for Turkey and Syria

Reacting to the recent earthquakes in Turkey and Syria, Pope Francis has asked Catholics to be in solidarity with the region. The death toll had reached close to 33,000 as of February 12, with the number of dead expected to climb further. Therefore, Bishop Checchio is asking parishes to have a 2nd Collection. Our parish will have a Second Collection for this purpose on Sunday, February 26. You can also donate to these two Catholic organizations who have already established online giving portals to assist:

Catholic Near East Welfare Association, has launched an emergency campaign to shelter survivors and provide bedding, food, medicines, nursing formula, diapers and clothing to more than 2,000 families for three months in the Aleppo and Hama areas of northern Syria. Anyone who would rather mail a check rather than give online can mail it to Catholic Near East Welfare Association, 1011 First Avenue, New York, NY 10022-4195 (they should indicate it is for earthquake relief on the check).

Catholic Relief Services, the overseas aid agency of the Catholic Church in the United States, was collecting funds to assist its local partners, Caritas Turkey and Caritas Syria, particularly in Aleppo and Lattakia, Syria, where extensive damage has been reported. Again, if anyone would prefer not to give online, their address is Catholic Relief Services, P.O. Box 5200, Harlan, IA 51593-0700 (they should indicate it is for earthquake relief on the check).

Presidents' Day

In view of Presidents' Day, the Parish Office will be closed on Monday, February, 20. There will be no Mass on that day.

2023 Lenten Obligations

1. The days of fast and abstinence are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
2. All other Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence (see note below with regards to March 17).
3. The obligation of fast applies only to Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59. Fasting in the Catholic tradition means to limit oneself to one full meal and two smaller meals which together are not equal to a full meal, so as to experience hunger.
4. The obligation of abstinence applies to all Catholics who have reached the age of 14. Abstinence in the Catholic tradition means to abstain from meat.

Note: This year, the Memorial of St. Patrick falls on a Friday. For members of the faithful celebrating this Memorial and who desire it, Bishop Checchio has commuted the penitential obligation on March 17 to the obligation to abstain from meat on another day that same week.

Continúa del Boletín del 12 de Febrero....

El Obispo Checchio nombró a Allan Caballero, Director de la Oficina de Evangelización, y al Padre James De Fillipps como los contactos para la Diócesis de Metuchen, de conformidad con el Vademécum sobre el sínodo emitido por el Vaticano. Se formó un Comité de Planificación del Sínodo Diocesano con la participación de Jennifer Ruggiero, Secretaria de la Secretaría para la Familia y la Vida Pastoral, quien se desempeñó como Presidenta. Pronto el comité comenzó el proceso de planificación y conducción de reuniones locales como parte de la fase diocesana del Sínodo, que incluyó un aumento de la oración, una serie de sesiones de escucha y oportunidades para motivar la escucha consciente del Espíritu Santo. El Comité preparó un sitio web del Sínodo y materiales para las Sesiones de Escucha del Sínodo: incluida una Guía de Recursos para Organizadores, una Guía para Facilitadores y una Guía para Participantes. Estos recursos, que se pusieron a disposición de las parroquias y grupos ministeriales de toda la diócesis, se desarrollaron para ayudar a planificar un proceso de sesión de escucha consistente con el llamado del Papa Francisco a "Caminar juntos como iglesia sinodal". Debido a la pandemia, el Comité también organizó varias Sesiones Virtuales de Capacitación de Facilitadores para preparar a los líderes parroquiales y ministeriales en conversaciones efectivas y espirituales. A finales de Enero se organizó en una parroquia de cada uno de los ocho decanatos de la diócesis, una Adoración Eucarística de 40 horas como una forma de ayudar a las personas a prepararse espiritualmente para el proceso sinodal, reflexionando en oración sobre las preguntas previamente planteadas por nuestro Santo Padre. El enfoque en la oración y en la Eucaristía fue un paso intencional que se dio con el fin de que el proceso no fuera de naturaleza parlamentaria, sino más bien un proceso de escucha sincera entre nosotros y del Espíritu Santo. Desafortunadamente, un aumento en los casos de Covid-19 causó un retraso en las sesiones de escucha en persona, pero, con la guía del Espíritu Santo, las sesiones se reprogramaron y se llevaron a cabo entre los meses de Febrero a Mayo, en cada decanato (entre-parroquias) y en parroquias y escuelas de toda la diócesis. Cada sesión comenzó con la oración Adsumus Sancte Spiritus, seguida de breves instrucciones sobre el proceso sinodal y las reglas básicas para las conversaciones espirituales.

323. It is a profound spiritual experience to contemplate our loved ones with the eyes of God and to see Christ in them. This demands a freedom and openness which enable us to appreciate their dignity. We can be fully present to others only by giving fully of ourselves and forgetting all else. We are constantly reminded that each of those who live with us merits complete attention, since he or she possesses infinite dignity as an object of the Father's immense love. This gives rise to a tenderness which can "stir in the other the joy of being loved. Tenderness is expressed in a particular way by exercising loving care in treating the limitations of the other, especially when they are evident".

Struggling to Believe in the Eucharist? If you are Catholic and struggling to believe in the Church's teaching on the Eucharist, you are not alone.

3 Ways To Grow In Your Belief Of The Eucharist

Think it Through and Draw on Tradition The bread and wine are transformed into the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ and not merely symbols. Jesus Christ Himself said, "This is my body" and "this is my blood." The appearances remain but the substance has changed. If the Eucharist is truly the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, under the veil of a Sacrament, then worship makes sense. During the Mass, we kneel before the Blessed Sacrament. The priest says, "Behold the Lamb of God" while holding up the Eucharist. He kneels and we kneel. If the Eucharist were merely a symbol, then we are worshipping bread and committing horrid blasphemy. This is the reality: the Eucharist is either Jesus or we are worshipping bread. *"It is not the man who is responsible for the offerings as they become Christ's Body and Blood; it is Christ Himself who was crucified for us. The standing figure belongs to the priest who speaks these words. The power and the grace belong to God."*

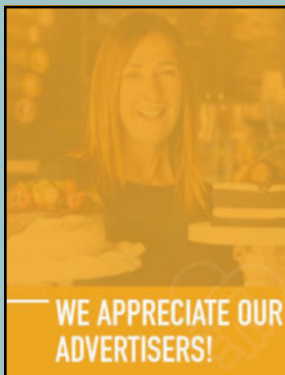

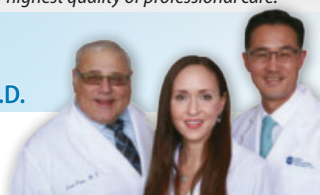
