The parish cannot issue certificates of eligibility for sacramental sponsorship, give recommendations or character references if a person is not an active parishioner.


The Sacrament of Baptism:

Baptism is the celebration through which a child is brought into the faith of the Catholic Church. Parents must be registered and practicing members of the parish. Parents and sponsors are required to attend a pre-baptismal class. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics in good standing and able to obtain a certificate of eligibility from their parish.

Sacrament of Matrimony: The Sacrament of Matrimony requires a time of spiritual, intellectual and emotional preparation. Couples should arrange with the Parish Office one (1) year prior to the wedding date. Please call the parish office for an appointment with the pastor prior to making any other wedding plans.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: Anyone who feels called by God to become a member of the Catholic Church participates in the RCIA Program. A series of instructions and liturgical ceremonies designed to give total formation in the Catholic Faith.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: Any parishioner who is sick, aged or incapacitated may receive the Eucharist at home. Please contact the Parish Office to have a priest visit you at home or in the hospital.



Continua del Boletín del 5 de Marzo... Muchos de los encuestados en línea también estaban confundidos o frustrados por las preguntas, pero no se sintieron limitados por ellas y se expresaron libremente. A continuación se muestra una breve reseña de algunos de los grupos más grandes que participaron en la fase diocesana del sínodo. Las palabras participantes У encuestadas se indistintamente en todas partes. Comunidad Hispana: En los últimos años, se ha presentado un rápido crecimiento de la población Hispana en todo el país, así como a nivel local y ahora 26 de las 90 parroquias en la Diócesis de Metuchen ofrecen intencionalmente a los Hispanos la Santa Misa, así como los Sacramentos y otros ministerios pastorales en español. La Oficina de Evangelización Hispana realizó ocho Sesiones de Escucha para la comunidad de habla hispana con la participación de 245 personas (67% mujeres y 33% hombres) aproximadamente el 81% de los participantes tenían entre 30 y 64 años. Teniendo un buen porcentaje de participantes más jóvenes en este grupo lo cual es una señal alentadora. Tres de las Sesiones de Escucha del Decanato fueron bilingües. Muchos en este grupo sugirieron que "consagrarse al Espíritu Santo es la forma más segura de participar en los tesoros de la salvación de Dios". También lamentaron que el no hablar el idioma Inglés y la falta de conocimiento bíblico les impide participar plenamente en la misión de la Iglesia. La mayoría estuvo de acuerdo en que la integración de las culturas en el culto y la comunidad parroquial es lo más importante para ellos.

Message of Pope Francis for Lent, 2023 Lenten Penance and the Synodal Journey

The Lenten journey of penance and the journey of the Synod alike have as their goal a transfiguration, both personal and ecclesial. A transformation that, in both cases, has its model in the Transfiguration of Jesus and is achieved by the grace of his paschal mystery. So that this transfiguration may become a reality in us this year, I would like to propose two "paths" to follow in order to ascend the mountain together with Jesus and, with him, to attain the goal.

The first path has to do with the command that God the Father addresses to the disciples on Mount Tabor as they contemplate Jesus transfigured. The voice from the cloud says: "Listen to him" (Mt 17:5). The first proposal, then, is very clear: we need to listen to Jesus. Lent is a time of grace to the extent that we listen to him as he speaks to us. And how does he speak to us? First, in the word of God, which the Church offers us in the liturgy. May that word not fall on deaf ears; if we cannot always attend Mass, let us study its daily biblical readings, even with the help of the internet. In addition to the Scriptures, the Lord speaks to us through our brothers and sisters, especially in the faces and the stories of those who are in need. Let me say something else, which is quite important for the synodal process: listening to Christ often takes place in listening to our brothers and sisters in the Church. Such mutual listening in some phases is the primary goal, but it remains always indispensable in the method and style of a synodal Church.

Chrism Mass: 4:00 PM Tuesday, April 4, 2023 Cathedral of St. Francis of Assisi, Metuchen

On Tuesday, April 4, 2023, Bishop James F. Checchio will celebrate the Chrism Mass with the priests of the Diocese. At the Mass, all priests make a Renewal of Commitment to Priestly Service, recommitting themselves to their Bishop and to their ministry to God and His People; the Bishop and all Priests then ask the people for a pledge of their prayerful support.

The Bishop will also bless and consecrate the Holy Oils, which each parish receives for the rites of anointing. The Oil of Catechumens is used to anoint infants and adults before their Baptism; the Oil of the Sick is used on the forehead and hands of the infirm in the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick; and Sacred Chrism is used to anoint the head of the newly baptized, the foreheads of confirmand, the hands of a priest at his ordination, the head of a bishop at his ordination, and the altar and walls of new churches.

All are encouraged to join in-person (or watch via livestream), the ancient, grace-filled Chrism Mass at the Cathedral of St. Francis of Assisi in Metuchen at 4:00 PM.
