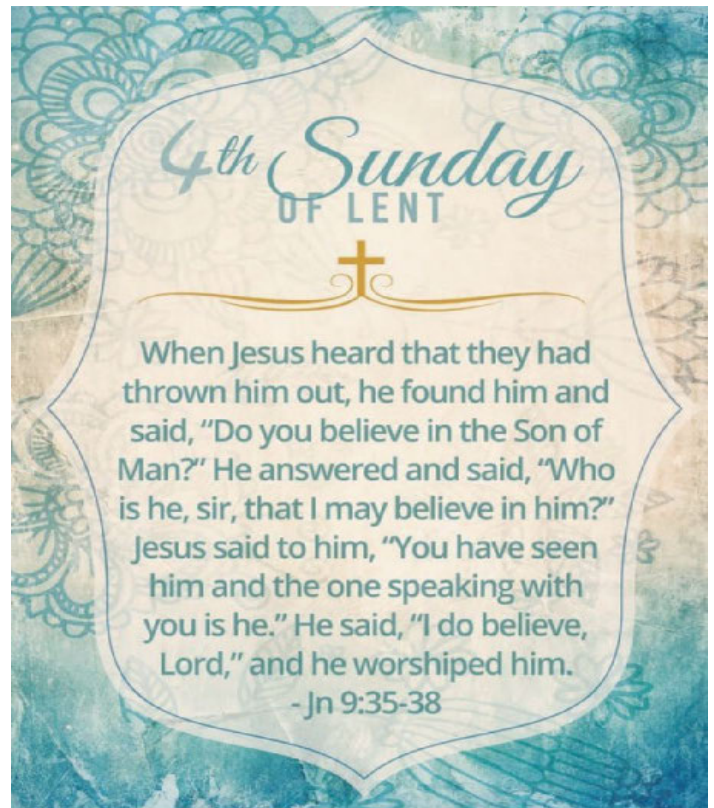
The Sacrament of Baptism:

Baptism is the celebration through which a child is brought into the faith of the Catholic Church. Parents must be registered and practicing members of the parish. Parents and sponsors are required to attend a pre-baptismal class. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics in good standing and able to obtain a certificate of eligibility from their parish.

Sacrament of Matrimony: The Sacrament of Matrimony requires a time of spiritual, intellectual and emotional preparation. Couples should arrange with the Parish Office one (1) year prior to the wedding date. Please call the parish office for an appointment with the pastor prior to making any other wedding plans.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: Anyone who feels called by God to become a member of the Catholic Church participates in the RCIA Program. A series of instructions and liturgical ceremonies designed to give total formation in the Catholic Faith.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: Any parishioner who is sick, aged or incapacitated may receive the Eucharist at home. Please contact the Parish Office to have a priest visit you at home or in the hospital.

MENSAJE DEL SANTO PADRE FRANCISCO PARA LA CAURESMA DE 2023: Continúa del Boletín del 5 de Marzo... Y llegamos al momento culminante. Dice el Evangelio que Jesús «se transfiguró en presencia de ellos: su rostro resplandecía como el sol y sus vestiduras se volvieron blancas como la luz» (Mt 17,2). Aquí está la «cumbre», la meta del camino. Al final de la subida, mientras estaban en lo alto del monte con Jesús, a los tres discípulos se les concedió la gracia de verle en su gloria, resplandeciente de luz sobrenatural. Una luz que no procedía del exterior, sino que se irradiaba de Él mismo. La belleza divina de esta visión fue incomparablemente mayor que cualquier esfuerzo que los discípulos hubieran podido hacer para subir al Tabor. Como en cualquier excursión exigente de montaña, a medida que se asciende es necesario mantener la mirada fija en el sendero; pero el maravilloso panorama que se revela al final, sorprende y hace que valga la pena. También el proceso sinodal parece a menudo un camino arduo, lo que a veces nos puede desalentar. Pero lo que nos espera al final es sin duda algo maravilloso y sorprendente, que nos ayudará a comprender mejor la voluntad de Dios y nuestra misión al servicio de su Reino. La experiencia de los discípulos en el monte Tabor se enriqueció aún más cuando, junto a Jesús transfigurado, aparecieron Moisés y Elías, que personifican respectivamente la Ley y los Profetas (cf. Mt 17,3). La novedad de Cristo es el cumplimiento de la antigua Alianza y de las promesas; es inseparable de la historia de Dios con su pueblo y revela su sentido profundo. De manera similar, el camino sinodal está arraigado en la tradición de la Iglesia y, al mismo tiempo, abierto a la novedad.

SÍNTESIS DE EL SÍNODO EN SINODALIDAD

La Diócesis Católica Romana de Metuchen Nueva Jersey, Estados Unidos de América
Octubre 2021 – Junio 2022

Continua del Boletín del 12 de Marzo...Encuestados en línea: Se recibieron un total de 128 cuestionarios en línea. Aproximadamente el 66% eran mujeres y el 33% hombres, el 94% informaron ser caucásicos. Casi el 100% de los encuestados asisten a Misa al menos semanalmente y alrededor del 18% informan que asisten a Misa en diferentes parroquias. **Escuelas Católicas Directores:** Se llevó a cabo una Sesión de Escucha virtual para los 23 directores de las Escuelas Católicas. Fueron sinceros en su deseo de encontrar soluciones y abordaron las preguntas desde esa perspectiva. Los directores sabían que facilitarían sus propias sesiones en sus escuelas y pueden haber estado preocupados por eso. Al final, se mostraron muy satisfechos con la sesión y agradecidos de haber participado. Esperan que sigamos teniendo estas discusiones. **Maestros:** Se llevaron a cabo Sesiones de Escucha para maestros en 17 de las 23 escuelas primarias y en las dos escuelas secundarias diocesanas. Aproximadamente 422 maestros participaron en los cuatro condados de la diócesis. Los resultados reflejan una combinación de perspectivas. • Se dieron algunas respuestas desde la perspectiva de los feligreses en varias parroquias; otros reflejan únicamente la vida escolar; y, finalmente, hay una combinación de la relación escuela/parroquia que solo refleja esta dinámica específica escuela/parroquia. • Hubo muchas referencias a que la Iglesia se movía demasiado lento y era vista como estricta o dura, pero sin mencionar ejemplos particulares. La presunción primordial fue el importante papel que el párroco debe desempeñar en la dirección de la parroquia y en el establecimiento del tono. Hay un fuerte deseo de ver al párroco brindando un ambiente acogedor para todos, especialmente para los jóvenes; y, realizando homilias que sean bien recibidas y que lleguen a todos.

**Message of Pope Francis for Lent, 2023
Lenten Penance and the Synodal Journey**

Pope's message for Lent 2023 Continued....On hearing the Father's voice, the disciples "fell prostrate and were very much afraid. But Jesus came and touched them, saying, 'Rise, and do not be afraid.' And when the disciples raised their eyes, they saw no one else but Jesus alone" (Mt 17:6-8). Here is the second proposal for this Lent: do not take refuge in a religiosity made up of extraordinary events and dramatic experiences, out of fear of facing reality and its daily struggles, its hardships and contradictions. The light that Jesus shows the disciples is an anticipation of Easter glory, and that must be the goal of our own journey, as we follow "him alone". Lent leads to Easter: the "retreat" is not an end in itself, but a means of preparing us to experience the Lord's passion and cross with faith, hope and love, and thus to arrive at the resurrection. Also on the synodal journey, when God gives us the grace of certain powerful experiences of communion, we should not imagine that we have arrived – for there too, the Lord repeats to us: "Rise, and do not be afraid". Let us go down, then, to the plain, and may the grace we have experienced strengthen us to be "artisans of synodality" in the ordinary life of our communities. Dear brothers and sisters, may the Holy Spirit inspire and sustain us this Lent in our ascent with Jesus, so that we may experience his divine splendour and thus, confirmed in faith, persevere in our journey together with him, glory of his people and light of the nations.

I am Sr. Kathleen Rooney, SSJ. I am a Chaplain at the Edna Mahan Correctional Facility for Women in Clinton, NJ. 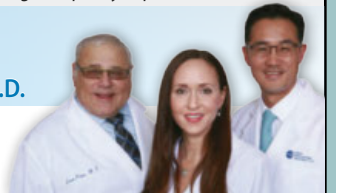
