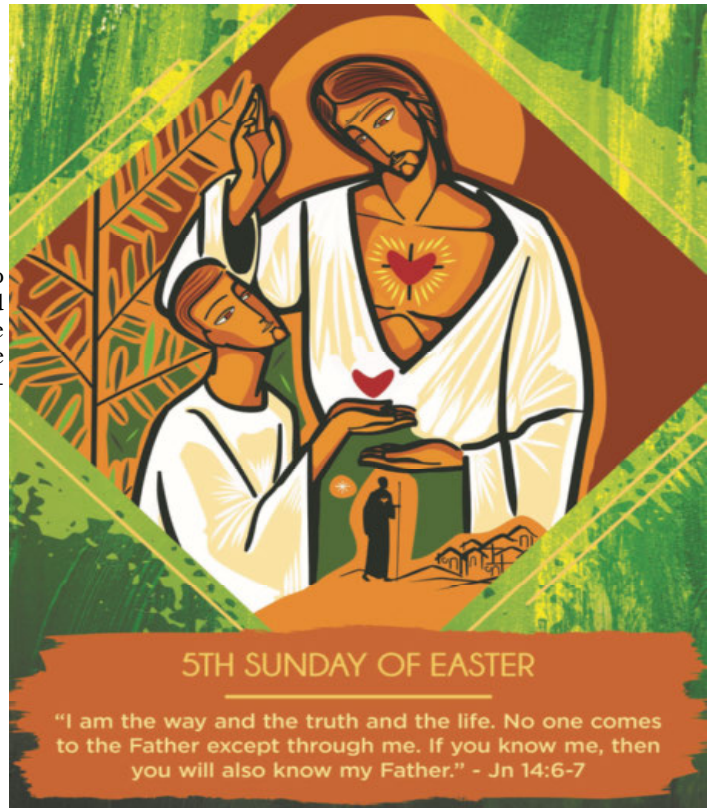
### **The Sacrament of Baptism:**

Baptism is the celebration through which a child is brought into the faith of the Catholic Church. Parents must be registered and practicing members of the parish. Parents and sponsors are required to attend a pre-baptismal class. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics in good standing and able to obtain a certificate of eligibility from their parish.

**Sacrament of Matrimony:** The Sacrament of Matrimony requires a time of spiritual, intellectual and emotional preparation. Couples should arrange with the Parish Office one (1) year prior to the wedding date. Please call the parish office for an appointment with the pastor prior to making any other wedding plans.

**Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults:** Anyone who feels called by God to become a member of the Catholic Church participates in the RCIA Program. A series of instructions and liturgical ceremonies designed to give total formation in the Catholic Faith.

**Pastoral Care of the Sick:** Any parishioner who is sick, aged or incapacitated may receive the Eucharist at home. Please contact the Parish Office to have a priest visit you at home or in the hospital.

**Chrism Mass: 4:00 PM Tuesday, April 4, 2023  
Cathedral of St. Francis of Assisi, Metuchen**

On Tuesday, April 4, 2023, Bishop James F. Checchio will celebrate the Chrism Mass with the priests of the Diocese. At the Mass, all priests make a Renewal of Commitment to Priestly Service, recommitting themselves to their Bishop and to their ministry to God and His People; the Bishop and all Priests then ask the people for a pledge of their prayerful support.

The Bishop will also bless and consecrate the Holy Oils, which each parish receives for the rites of anointing. The Oil of Catechumens is used to anoint infants and adults before their Baptism; the Oil of the Sick is used on the forehead and hands of the infirm in the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick; and Sacred Chrism is used to anoint the head of the newly baptized, the foreheads of confirmand, the hands of a priest at his ordination, the head of a bishop at his ordination, and the altar and walls of new churches.

All are encouraged to join in-person (or watch via livestream), the ancient, grace-filled Chrism Mass at the Cathedral of St. Francis of Assisi in Metuchen at 4:00 PM.

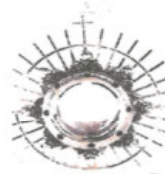
**Continua del Boletín del 19 de Marzo...** Jóvenes y Jóvenes Adultos Estudiantes católicos de secundaria: Las sesiones de escucha de los estudiantes se llevaron a cabo en ambas escuelas secundarias. Había aproximadamente 180 representantes de los cuatro grados en cada escuela. Las escuelas colaboraron y escribieron nuevas preguntas que serían más aplicables en la escuela secundaria. Las respuestas brindan una imagen de una Iglesia con números cada vez menores que está tratando de encontrar maneras de traer a más personas de vuelta a la fe. Los estudiantes sienten que necesitamos hacer cambios rápidamente si queremos salvar a la Iglesia; que es vista como estricta, dura y no inclusiva. No se dieron ejemplos concretos. Cuando se les pregunta acerca de lo más destacado de su vida en la Iglesia, la mayoría de los estudiantes se refieren a la recepción de sacramentos o experiencias como líderes en retiros. A partir de esta sesión, quedó claro que hay una necesidad de más oportunidades para ayudar a los jóvenes a desarrollar una relación personal con Cristo.

### **MENSAJE DEL SANTO PADRE FRANCISCO PARA LA CUARESMA 2023: Continua del Boletín del 19 de Marzo...**

La tradición es fuente de inspiración para buscar nuevos caminos, evitando las tentaciones opuestas del inmovilismo y de la experimentación improvisada. El camino ascético cuaresmal, al igual que el sinodal, tiene como meta una transfiguración personal y eclesial. Una transformación que, en ambos casos, halla su modelo en la de Jesús y se realiza mediante la gracia de su misterio pascual. Para que esta transfiguración pueda realizarse en nosotros este año, quisiera proponer dos "caminos" a seguir para ascender junto a 2 Jesús y llegar con Él a la meta. El primero se refiere al imperativo que Dios Padre dirigió a los discípulos en el Tabor, mientras contemplaban a Jesús transfigurado. La voz que se oyó desde la nube dijo: «Escúchenlo» (Mt 17,5). Por tanto, la primera indicación es muy clara: escuchar a Jesús. La Cuaresma es un tiempo de gracia en la medida en que escuchamos a Aquel que nos habla. ¿Y cómo nos habla? Ante todo, en la Palabra de Dios, que la Iglesia nos ofrece en la liturgia. No dejemos que caiga en saco roto. Si no podemos participar siempre en la Misa, meditemos las lecturas bíblicas de cada día, incluso con la ayuda de internet. Además de hablarnos en las Escrituras, el Señor lo hace a través de nuestros hermanos y hermanas, especialmente en los rostros y en las historias de quienes necesitan ayuda. Pero quisiera añadir también otro aspecto, muy importante en el proceso sinodal: el escuchar a Cristo pasa también por la escucha a nuestros hermanos y hermanas en la Iglesia; esa escucha recíproca que en algunas fases es el objetivo principal, y que, de todos modos, siempre es indispensable en el método y en el estilo de una Iglesia sinodal.

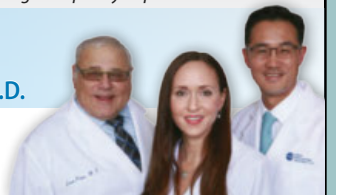

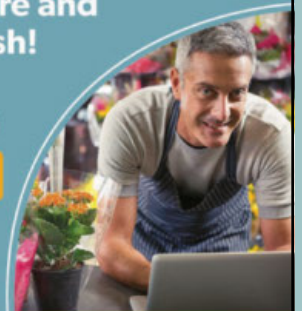
