
The Sacrament of Baptism:

Parents and sponsors are required to attend a pre-baptismal class. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics in good standing and able to obtain a certificate of eligibility from their parish.

Sacrament of Matrimony: The Sacrament of Matrimony requires a time of spiritual, intellectual and emotional preparation. Couples should arrange with the Parish Office one (1) year prior to the wedding date. Please call the parish office for an appointment with the pastor prior to making any other wedding plans.

<u>Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults:</u> Anyone who feels called by God to become a member of the Catholic Church participates in the RCIA Program. A series of instructions and liturgical ceremonies designed to give total formation in the Catholic Faith

Pastoral Care of the Sick: Any parishioner who is sick, aged or incapacitated may receive the Eucharist at home. Please contact the Parish Office to have a priest visit you at home or in the hospital.

Second Collection

The Second Collection on this weekend will be for the **2023 Missionary Cooperative Plan** to help the Archdiocese of Freetown in Sierra Leone West Africa. The Archbishop's Office supports the financially weak communities with proceeds from the mission appeals. It is our hope that the proceeds from the 2023 appeals would support the church building project of St Theresa of the Child Jesus Catholic Community in Campbell Town, outside Waterloo. The Archdiocese will also support social programs - Hospital and Clinics, including orphans, vulnerable and marginalized.

Rev. Peter Konteh is a priest of the Archdiocese of Sierra Leone, West Africa. He is the Executive Director, Caritas Freetown. Fr. Peter as he is fondly called, began social work over 30 years ago. Fr. Peter Konteh is the Chairman and Technical Supervisor in Sierra Leone for the Healey International Relief Foundation, an American (New Jersey- based) humanitarian organization that works on child protection, education, health, and social services in Sierra Leone. Rev. Fr. Peter duly leads the development arm of the Catholic Diocese of Freetown. His commitment to continue his pastoral duties, support for the work of the church and care for others is manifested in his drive to raise funds and seek sustainable development interventions at both community and national levels, in and out of the church. It reaffirms his role as the Executive Director of the Archdiocesan Development Office/ Caritas Freetown, as a solid partner for peace and development.


