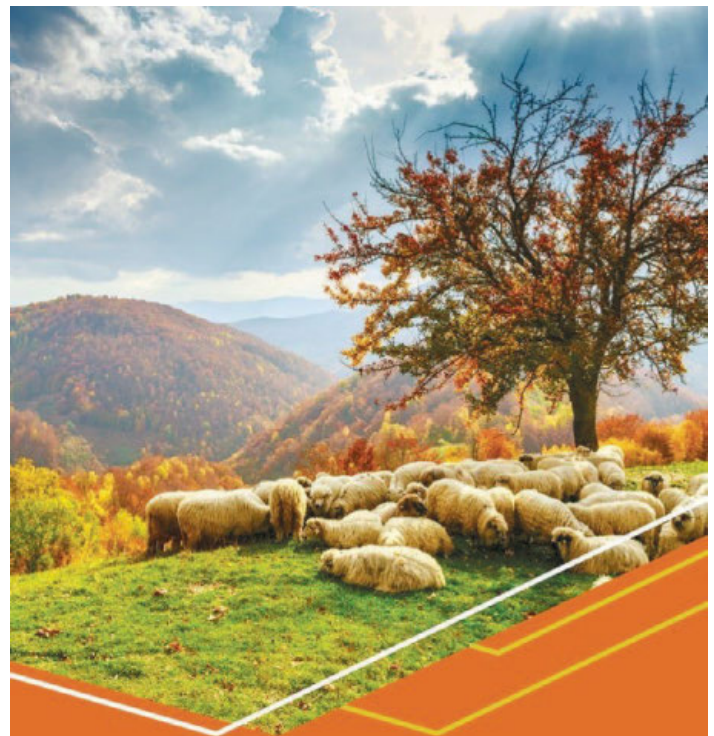
The Sacrament of Baptism:

Baptism is the celebration through which a child is brought into the faith of the Catholic Church. Parents must be registered and practicing members of the parish. Parents and sponsors are required to attend a pre-baptismal class. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics in good standing and able to obtain a certificate of eligibility from their parish.

Sacrament of Matrimony: The Sacrament of Matrimony requires a time of spiritual, intellectual and emotional preparation. Couples should arrange with the Parish Office one (1) year prior to the wedding date. Please call the parish office for an appointment with the pastor prior to making any other wedding plans.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: Anyone who feels called by God to become a member of the Catholic Church participates in the RCIA Program. A series of instructions and liturgical ceremonies designed to give total formation in the Catholic Faith

Pastoral Care of the Sick: Any parishioner who is sick, aged or incapacitated may receive the Eucharist at home. Please contact the Parish Office to have a priest visit you at home or in the hospital.

Synthesis of the Interim Phase – Synod on Synodality

Question 1: Where have I seen or experienced successes – and distresses – within the Church's structure (s)/ organization/leadership/life that encourage or hinder the mission?

“Success: when a pastor encourages the Hispanic community by guiding them in projects for the Church and community. Distress: when he doesn't get involved with the community and doesn't communicate with them.”

“Few parishes have ministries aimed at Hispanic youth, nor do they offer them the space to live their faith through service.”

“Parishes carry out cultural activities to capture the attention of people who don't frequently attend Mass, then invite them to participate in a ministry. The response has been positive and many are now faithful parishioners.”

Success – when clergy and parishioners are welcoming to everyone.

Success – There is now more focus on the Eucharist and Eucharistic adoration.

Distress – When clergy and religious are too busy with administrative tasks to spend time with parishioners.

Success – Pastoral leadership welcomes the work of the young Laity. They give youth leadership roles that gives them an ownership in the ministry. “I saw success as a youth attending youth group and was able to grow spiritually. Now I am growing a youth ministry at my own parish.”

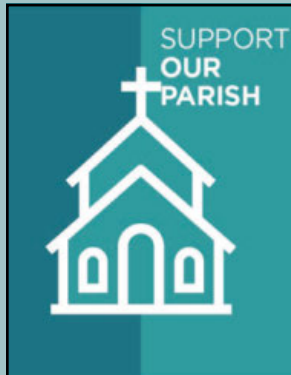

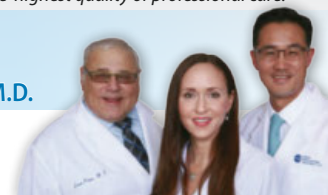

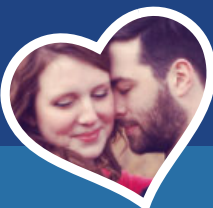
