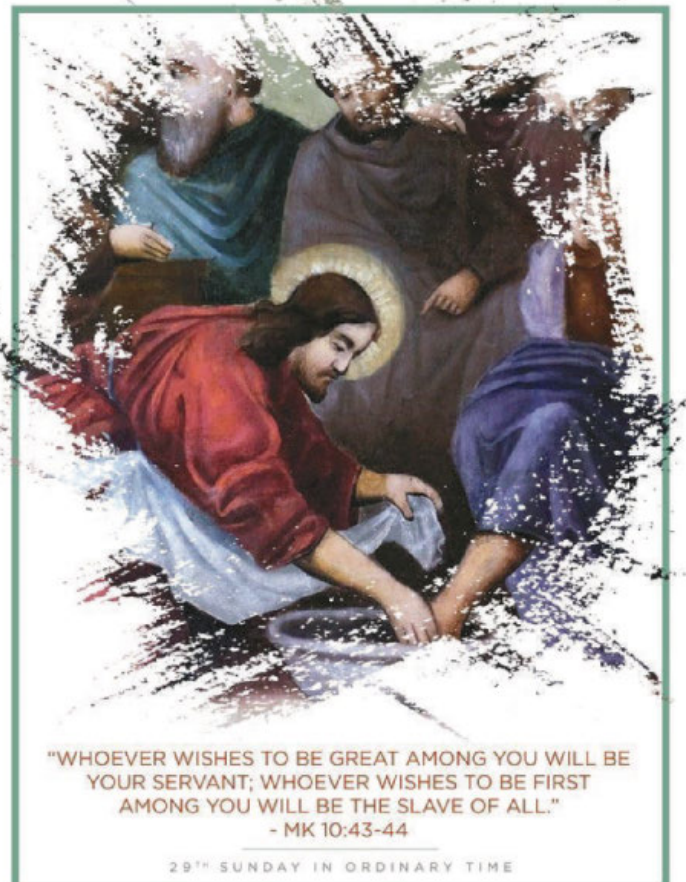
The Sacrament of Baptism:

Baptism is the celebration through which a child is brought into the faith of the Catholic Church. Parents must be registered and practicing members of the parish. Parents and sponsors are required to attend a pre-baptismal class. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics in good standing and able to obtain a certificate of eligibility from their parish.

Sacrament of Matrimony: The Sacrament of Matrimony requires a time of spiritual, intellectual and emotional preparation. Couples should arrange with the Parish Office one (1) year prior to the wedding date. Please call the parish office for an appointment with the pastor prior to making any other wedding plans.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: Anyone who feels called by God to become a member of the Catholic Church participates in the RCIA Program. A series of instructions and liturgical ceremonies designed to give total formation in the Catholic Faith

Pastoral Care of the Sick: Any parishioner who is sick, aged or incapacitated may receive the Eucharist at home. Please contact the Parish Office to have a priest visit you at home or in the hospital.



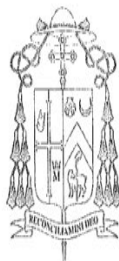

Hurricane Relief: St. Michael the Archangel Church, Erwin, TN

One of the hardest hit communities by hurricane Helene was St. Michael the Archangel Church in Erwin, TN, Diocese of Knoxville, TN. Fr. Tom Charters, the pastor of the parish, has been ministering to all the needs of his parishioners and the community at large, since the Catholic population is the minority in east TN, since Friday, September 27. The parish lost the lives of 6 of their parishioners due to the flash flooding that occurred in the region and many remain missing. Fr. Tom said the parish has become a gathering point for people, Catholic and non-Catholic, seeking aid and shelter, as well as spiritual comfort. Fr. Tom said families from every background, including some from nearby Asheville, NC, are turning to the Catholic Church for help. Right now, Fr. Tom said they are simply responding to the basic needs of the community as best as they can. This is a parish community that will definitely need support for the long road to recovery. The community is made up of hardworking, faith filled families, who are rich in faith, but poor in the financial sense. Thank you for your generous response. God bless. Fr. Abraham





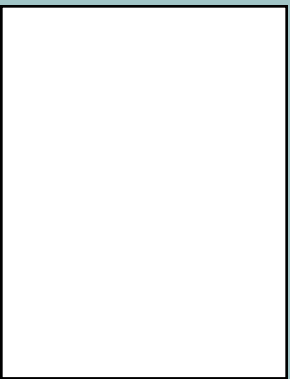

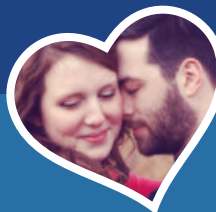
