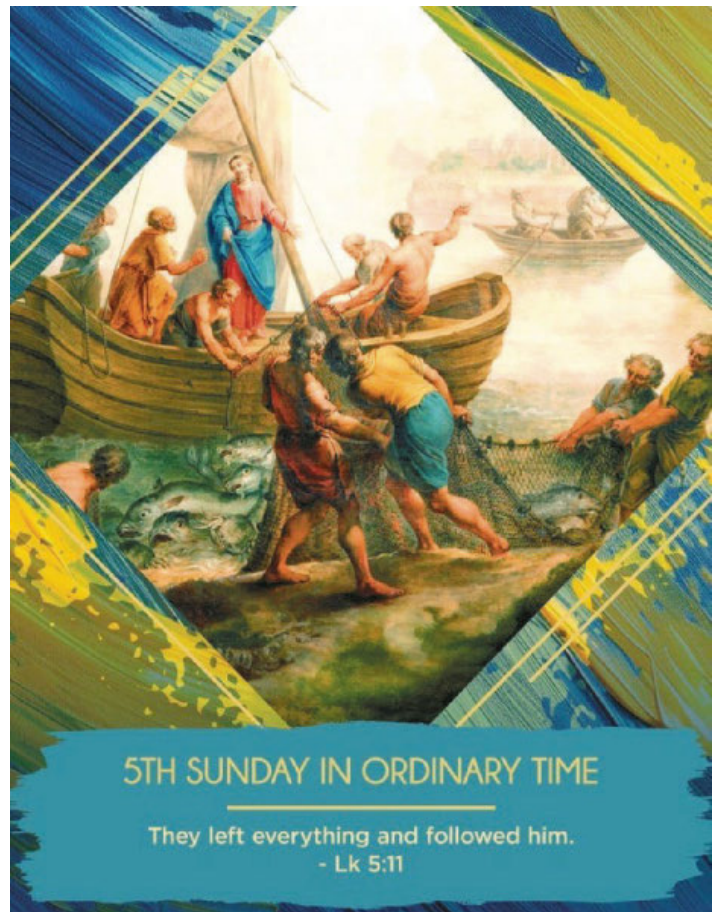
#### The Sacrament of Baptism:

Baptism is the celebration through which a child is brought into the faith of the Catholic Church. Parents must be registered and practicing members of the parish. Parents and sponsors are required to attend a pre-baptismal class. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics in good standing and able to obtain a certificate of eligibility from their parish.

**Sacrament of Matrimony:** The Sacrament of Matrimony requires a time of spiritual, intellectual and emotional preparation. Couples should arrange with the Parish Office one (1) year prior to the wedding date. Please call the parish office for an appointment with the pastor prior to making any other wedding plans.

**Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults:** Anyone who feels called by God to become a member of the Catholic Church participates in the RCIA Program. A series of instructions and liturgical ceremonies designed to give total formation in the Catholic Faith

**Pastoral Care of the Sick:** Any parishioner who is sick, aged or incapacitated may receive the Eucharist at home. Please contact the Parish Office to have a priest visit you at home or in the hospital.

**Save the Dates: Pilgrimages**

**Jubilee 2025: Papal Bull**



Tradition dictates that each Jubilee is proclaimed through the publication of a Papal (or Pontifical) 'Bull of Indiction'. By 'Bull' is meant an official document, generally written in Latin, bearing the seal of the Pope, the shape of which gives its name to the document itself.

In the past the seal was usually made of lead and bore, on the front, the image of the Holy Apostles Peter and Paul, founders of the Church of Rome, and, on the back, the name of the current Pontiff. Later an ink stamp replaced the metal seal, which, however, continued to be used for more important documents.

Each Bull is identified by its initial words. For example, Saint John Paul II proclaimed the Great Jubilee of the Year 2000 with the Bull Incarnationis Mysterium (The Mystery of the Incarnation), while Pope Francis proclaimed the Extraordinary Jubilee of Mercy (2015-2016) with the Bull Misericordiae vultus (The face of mercy).

The Bull announcing the Jubilee, which indicates the dates of the beginning and end of the Holy Year, is usually issued the previous year, coinciding with the Solemnity of the Ascension. For the 2025 Jubilee, publication is expected on May 9, 2024. (Source: Vatican)

**LINEAMIENTOS LEGALES EN CASO DE UNA REDADA DE INMIGRACIÓN**

**Para Escuelas y Parroquias**

En el evento que un oficial de inmigración realice una visita o redada en las instalaciones, tenga en cuenta lo siguiente:

1. Mantenga la calma; sea cortés – Esto puede ayudar a evitar una escalada de emociones.
2. Pídale que se identifiquen.  
A. Pídale que muestren su identificación y que expliquen quiénes son.

3. **Los funcionarios de ICE o DHS deben tener una orden judicial para ingresar a las instalaciones.** Los oficiales de inmigración son libres de ingresar a cualquier área *pública* de su lugar de trabajo, pero deben tener una orden de registro válida o su consentimiento para ingresar a áreas *no públicas*. Pídale a las autoridades que le entreguen una copia de la orden para su inspección. Si no se cumplen los requisitos de la orden judicial que se indican a continuación, usted no está obligado a permitir que las autoridades ingresen a las instalaciones.

A. La orden debe:

- Estar firmada por un juez de un tribunal estatal o federal (no un juez de un tribunal de inmigración).
- Especificar un período de tiempo dentro del cual debe realizarse la búsqueda.
- Identificar la ubicación o las instalaciones específicas que las autoridades tienen la intención de registrar.
- Incluir una lista de los artículos que se van a registrar e incautar.
- El nombre de la(s) persona(s) específica(s) que las autoridades tienen la intención de arrestar, si las hubiera.

C. Una orden administrativa para la deportación o arresto de un extranjero NO califica.

4. **Su organización puede aceptar la orden judicial, pero no dar su consentimiento para el registro.** Si no da su consentimiento para el registro, el registro continuará, pero puede impugnarlo posteriormente si hay motivos para hacerlo. No obstante, si la orden judicial es válida no puede obstruir el registro.

**Conozca sus derechos: Derechos de los inmigrantes**

Todas las personas que viven o visitan New Jersey tienen derechos, independientemente de su ciudadanía o estatus migratorio. La siguiente información está diseñada para ayudarle a entender sus derechos y responsabilidades cuando interactúe con agentes de inmigración, principalmente el Servicio de Inmigración y Control de Aduanas (ICE, por sus siglas en inglés) o la Oficina de Aduanas y Protección Fronteriza de EE.UU. (CBP, por sus siglas en inglés).

*Tenga en cuenta que el ICE puede entrar en cualquier espacio público sin necesidad de ningún tipo de orden judicial. Los espacios públicos pueden incluir: áreas específicas en el lugar de trabajo, vestíbulo de la oficina, supermercado, tienda al por menor, o zona de comedor de un restaurante.*

**Si se encuentra con un agente de inmigración u otras fuerzas del orden en un espacio público:**

- Puede pedir ver su placa / identificación. Si no está seguro de que el agente sea un agente de inmigración, puede preguntar a qué organismo representa y, en concreto, si son agentes federales de inmigración.
- Puede preguntar si es libre de retirarse.
- Tiene derecho a permanecer en silencio y no está obligado a responder a ninguna pregunta. Puede decirle al agente de inmigración que prefiere permanecer en silencio.
- Si no es ciudadano estadounidense y un agente de inmigración le pide su documentación de inmigración, debe mostrarla si la lleva consigo. Si no tiene documentación en el momento del encuentro, puede decirle al agente que desea permanecer en silencio o que desea consultar a un abogado antes de responder a cualquier pregunta.
  - Lleve consigo en todo momento una identificación válida del gobierno de Estados Unidos.
  - Si tiene documentación de inmigración, lleve consigo en todo momento los documentos de inmigración válidos, incluyendo su tarjeta de autorización de empleo, y copias de sus I-94 y avisos de comparecencia con usted en todo momento.
  - Los documentos extranjeros se deben dejar en casa seguros en todo momento.
  - No lleve documentos falsos o fraudulentos, y nunca proporcione documentos falsos o fraudulentos a un oficial de policía o agente de inmigración.
- Si un agente de inmigración le pregunta si puede registrarle, usted tiene derecho a negarse. Los agentes no tienen derecho a registrarle a usted o sus pertenencias sin su consentimiento, una orden válida o una causa probable. Sin embargo, si los agentes le registran de todos modos, no se resista. Puede decirles: "No consiento el registro. Deseo permanecer en silencio. Deseo hablar con un abogado lo antes posible."
- Puede pedir un intérprete si no hablan su idioma.

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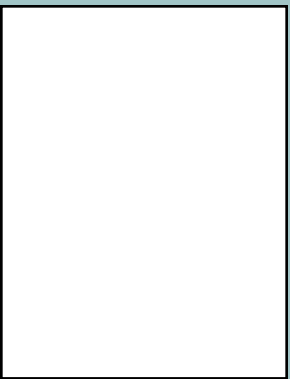
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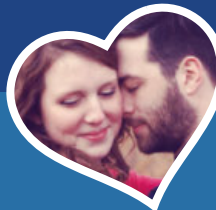
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
