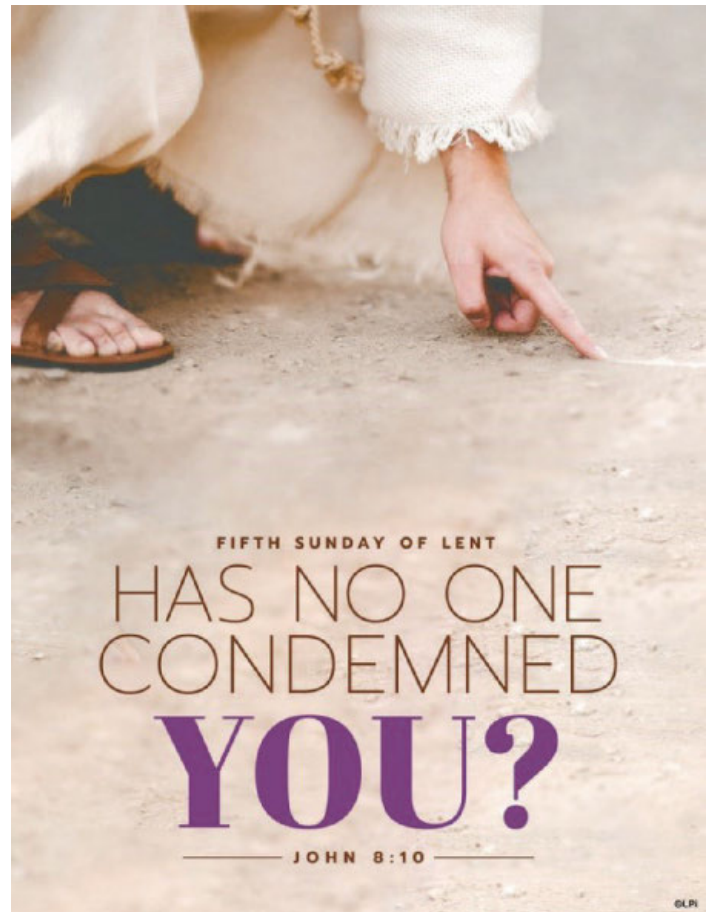
The Sacrament of Baptism:

Baptism is the celebration through which a child is brought into the faith of the Catholic Church. Parents must be registered and practicing members of the parish. Parents and sponsors are required to attend a pre-baptismal class. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics in good standing and able to obtain a certificate of eligibility from their parish.

Sacrament of Matrimony: The Sacrament of Matrimony requires a time of spiritual, intellectual and emotional preparation. Couples should arrange with the Parish Office one (1) year prior to the wedding date. Please call the parish office for an appointment with the pastor prior to making any other wedding plans.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: Anyone who feels called by God to become a member of the Catholic Church participates in the RCIA Program. A series of instructions and liturgical ceremonies designed to give total formation in the Catholic Faith

Pastoral Care of the Sick: Any parishioner who is sick, aged or incapacitated may receive the Eucharist at home. Please contact the Parish Office to have a priest visit you at home or in the hospital.

**Message of the Holy Father Francis
for Lent 2025:
Let us journey together in Hope**

Dear brothers and sisters,

Second, to journey *together*. The Church is called to walk together, to be synodal^[2] Christians are called to walk at the side of others, and never as lone travelers. The Holy Spirit impels us not to remain self-absorbed, but to leave ourselves behind and keep walking towards God and our brothers and sisters.^[3] Journeying together means consolidating the unity grounded in our common dignity as children of God (cf. *Gal3:26-28*). It means walking side-by-side, without shoving or stepping on others, without envy or hypocrisy, without letting anyone be left behind or excluded. Let us all walk in the same direction, tending towards the same goal, attentive to one another in love and patience.

This Lent, God is asking us to examine whether in our lives, in our families, in the places where we work and spend our time, we are capable of walking together with others, listening to them, resisting the temptation to become self-absorbed and to think only of our own needs. Let us ask ourselves in the presence of the Lord whether, as bishops, priests, consecrated persons and laity in the service of the Kingdom of God, we cooperate with others. Whether we show ourselves welcoming, with concrete gestures, to those both near and far. Whether we make others feel a part of the community or keep them at a distance. ^[4] This, then, is a second call to conversion: a summons to Synodality.

Third, let us journey together *in hope*, for we have been given a promise. May the hope that does not disappoint (cf. *Rom5:5*), the central message of the Jubilee, ^[5] be the focus of our Lenten journey towards the victory of Easter. As Pope Benedict XVI taught us in the Encyclicals *Salvi*, “the human being needs unconditional love. He needs the certainty which makes him say: ‘neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord’ (*Rom8:38-39*)”. ^[6] Christ, my hope, has risen! ^[7] He lives and reigns in glory. Death has been transformed into triumph, and the faith and great hope of Christians rests in this: the resurrection of Christ!

Lent 2025: 40 Days 40 Items

Once again, this year, we are conducting our 40 items for 40 days of Lent as a practice for our spiritual growth. Beginning on Ash Wednesday, March 5, put one item a day in a basket. It can be non-perishable food, NEW socks, t-shirts, slippers, underwear, baby and toddler clothes, diapers, bottles and blankets.

All items will be brought to Guardian Angels or St. Paul's on Palm Sunday. These items will be distributed to St. Vincent de Paul, Veterans, pregnancy aid, and the homeless in our area. We encourage all our parishioners to take part in this Lenten exercise.

**Mensaje del Santo Padre Francisco para
la Cuaresma 2025:
Caminemos juntos en la esperanza**

Queridos hermanos y hermanas:

En segundo lugar, hagamos este viaje juntos. La vocación de la Iglesia es caminar juntos, ser sinodales [2]. Los cristianos están llamados a hacer camino juntos, nunca como viajeros solitarios. El Espíritu Santo nos impulsa a salir de nosotros mismos para ir hacia Dios y hacia los hermanos, y nunca a encerrarnos en nosotros mismos [3]. Caminar juntos significa ser artesanos de unidad, partiendo de la dignidad común de hijos de Dios (cf. Ga 3,26-28); significa caminar codo a codo, sin pisotear o dominar al otro, sin albergar envidia o hipocresía, sin dejar que nadie se quede atrás o se sienta excluido. Vamos en la misma dirección, hacia la misma meta, escuchándonos los unos a los otros con amor y paciencia.

En esta cuaresma, Dios nos pide que comprobemos si en nuestra vida, en nuestras familias, en los lugares donde trabajamos, en las comunidades parroquiales o religiosas, somos capaces de caminar con los demás, de escuchar, de vencer la tentación de encerrarnos en nuestra autorreferencialidad, ocupándonos solamente de nuestras necesidades. Preguntémonos ante el Señor si somos capaces de trabajar juntos como obispos, presbíteros, consagrados y laicos, al servicio del Reino de Dios; si tenemos una actitud de acogida, con gestos concretos, hacia las personas que se acercan a nosotros y a cuantos están lejos; si hacemos que la gente se sienta parte de la comunidad o si la marginamos [4]. Esta es una segunda llamada: la conversión a la Sinodalidad.

En tercer lugar, recorramos este camino juntos en la esperanza de una promesa. La esperanza que no defrauda (cf. Rm 5,5), mensaje central del Jubileo [5], sea para nosotros el horizonte del camino cuaresmal hacia la victoria pascual. Como nos enseñó el Papa Benedicto XVI en la Encíclica Spe salvi, «el ser humano necesita un amor incondicionado. Necesita esa certeza que le hace decir: “Ni muerte, ni vida, ni ángeles, ni principados, ni presente, ni futuro, ni potencias, ni altura, ni profundidad, ni criatura alguna podrá apartarnos del amor de Dios, manifestado en Cristo Jesús, Señor nuestro” (Rm 8,38-39)» [6]. Jesús, nuestro amor y nuestra esperanza, ha resucitado [7], y vive y reina glorioso. La muerte ha sido transformada en victoria y en esto radica la fe y la esperanza de los cristianos, en la resurrección de Cristo.

Proyecto de Cuaresma 2025

Esta temporada de Cuaresma, la comunidad parroquial de la **Transfiguración del Señor** se está asociando con **Catholic Extension Society** para ayudar a hacer realidad el sueño de expansión de los residentes de Nuestra Señora del Desierto en el Estado Central de Washington. La parroquia de **Our Lady of the Desert** fue construida en 1987 en un terreno donado por un agricultor local. La iglesia fue construida para albergar a 180 personas porque la población en ese momento era de 300. La población ahora es de alrededor de 3,300 personas y las misas de fin de semana a menudo atiende a 1,400 católicos o más. En la clase de confirmación del año pasado, 120 estudiantes realizaron sus sacramentos en un altar improvisado al aire libre de la plaza parroquial. Durante los últimos 12 años, la comunidad ha estado recaudando fondos incansablemente para esta expansión mientras continúan planificando y creciendo para el futuro. Una de sus campanas más exitosas ha sido la venta de miel donada localmente y el 100 % de las ganancias se destinara al proyecto de construcción. El espacio de adoración ampliado tendrá capacidad para 450 personas adicionales para la liturgia regular. Las nuevas oficinas y áreas de reunión apoyaran los programas de educación religiosa y formación en la fe. Se agregaran baños adicionales. La comunidad está ahora cerca de completar su objetivo de recaudación de fondos, ¡y podemos ayudarlos a cruzar la línea de la meta!

Lenten Project 2025

Our Parish Lenten Project this year, in collaboration with Catholic Extension, will be to help Our Lady of the Desert Parish in the Diocese of Yakima, Washington State.

Building Catholic faith communities increases a sense of belonging among remote communities especially among the poor. Our Lady of the Desert parish in Mattawa, WA, was built in 1987 on land donated by a local farmer. The church was built to seat 180 people because the population at that time was 300. The population now is around 3,300 people with weekend Masses often serving 1,400 Catholics. The current church is not inadequate for the needs of the community and is in need of expansion. Last year's confirmation class saw 120 students make their sacraments on a makeshift altar in the open air of the parish plaza.

For the past 12 years, the community has been fundraising tirelessly for the expansion of the worship space. One of their most successful campaigns has been selling locally donated honey, with 100% of the proceeds supporting the building project. The expanded worship space will accommodate 450 additional people for regular liturgy. New offices and meeting areas will support religious education programs. Additional restrooms will be added. The community is now close to completing their fundraising goal. We can help them cross the finish line!

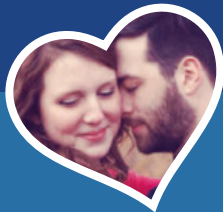
