Active membership is determined by registration, faithful participation and giving of one's time, talent and resources to this community of faith. **The parish cannot issue certificates of eligibility for sacramental sponsorship, give recommendations or character references if a person is not active parishioner.**

#### **The Sacrament of Baptism:**

Parents and sponsors are required to attend a pre-baptismal class. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics in good standing and able to obtain a certificate of eligibility from their parish.

#### **Sacrament of Matrimony:**

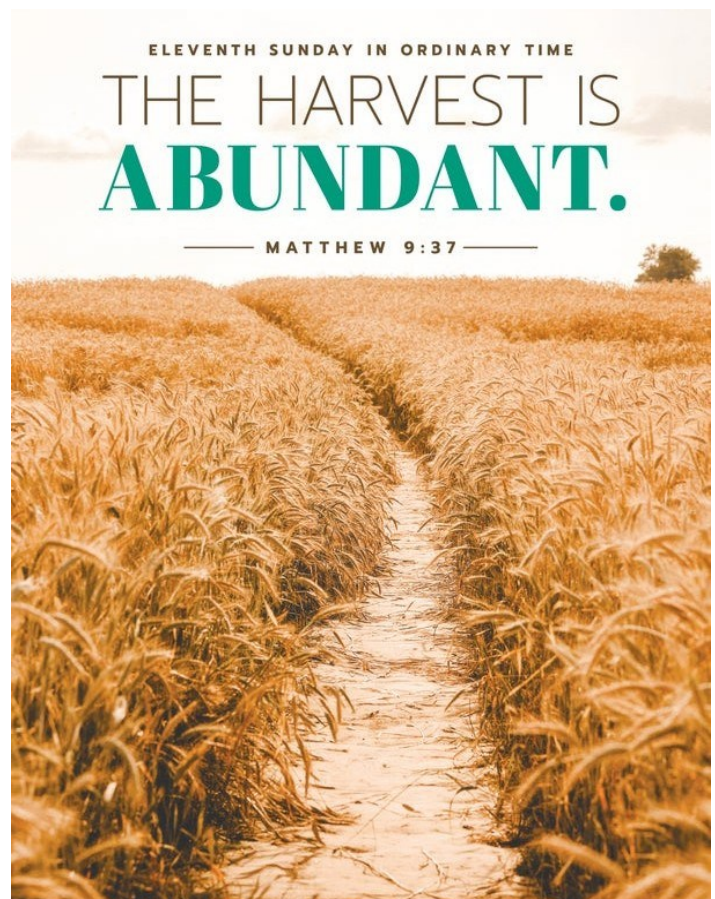

## Magnifica Humanitas

La Encíclica del Papa León XIV sobre la custodia de la persona humana en el tiempo de la inteligencia artificial

La dignidad del ser humano como criterio para orientar el progreso tecnológico.

*El Papa León XIV, al presentar al mundo y a todo el pueblo de Dios su primera Carta Encíclica sobre la custodia de la persona humana en tiempo de la inteligencia artificial, declaró: "Invito a todos los miembros de la Iglesia y de la familia humana: aprendamos a escucharnos unos a otros, afrontemos con valentía los desafíos presentes y cooperemos en la construcción de una sociedad más humana y fraterna. [...] Por favor, lleven con ustedes el compromiso de permanecer despiertos y ser 'artesanos de esperanza' para seguir construyendo la obra de nuestro tiempo. Que el Espíritu del Señor Resucitado sostenga nuestro trabajo común".*

### La Encíclica, en síntesis:

Así llegamos al núcleo de la cuestión, es decir, **la relación entre tecnología, poder y persona humana (cap. 3)**. Aunque el Papa León reconoce el valor del desarrollo tecnológico como manifestación de la creatividad humana, advierte del riesgo de que este se erija en criterio absoluto de juicio. Las inteligencias artificiales, al carecer de experiencias, valores y sentimientos, no pueden ni deben asumir jamás una función de responsabilidad y supremacía sobre la inteligencia humana.

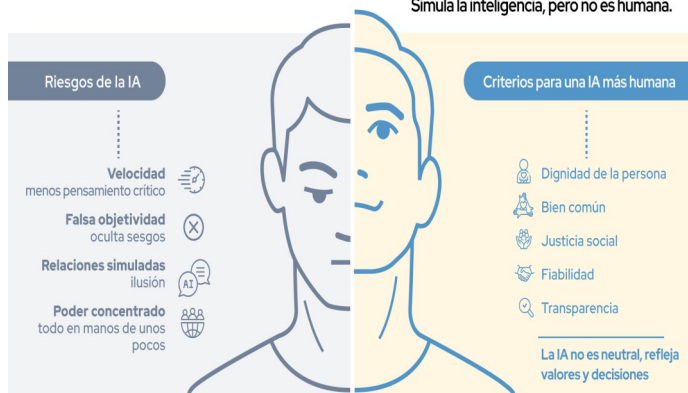

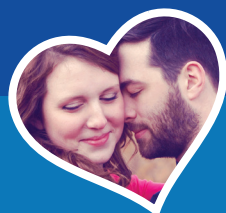
